

## MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WEDNESDAY, MAY 14TH, A.D. 1919, 3 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.

At this meeting came on to be considered the returns of a regular election held on the 13th day of May, 1919, for municipal officers as follows, to-wit: For Mayor, for Commissioner of Taxation, for Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public Property, for Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements, and for Commissioner of Police and Fire, all as stated in the proclamation ordering said election.

On motion of His Honor, Mayor Bell, duly seconded and carried, the Commissioners resolved themselves into a Committee of the whole to canvass the returns of said election and report thereon; and said Committee having canvassed said returns reported as recorded on pages 68 and 69 of the Book of Consolidated Election Returns, and the Commissioners re-convened:

Commissioner Coy offered the following resolution, which was adopted:

## RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio have this day canvassed the returns of a regular City Election held on the 13th day of May, 1919, and have made report thereon, and

WHEREAS, it has been found that the election was held and conducted, and the returns and canvass thereof made as provided by law, and the Commissioners having found said returns and said report in all respects correct, said report is hereby adopted, and it is ordered that the candidates who have received the highest number of votes cast in said election for their respective offices, as shown by said returns and canvass made this day, be and they are hereby declared elected, and that certificates of election be issued to each of them as by Law provided.

Petition of Hyde and Johnston for permit to cut the sidewalk and curbing on Travis Street near the intersection of St. Mary was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
