An ordinance accepting proposal of Reiwald Armond Company for constructing sanitary sewers and authorizing contract and appropriating money therefor.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. (Acceptance) That the City does hereby accept the attached written proposal of said party named in the caption hereof, dated September 2, 1920 and offering to construct Bushnell Street Sanitary Sewer main (Contract Section 63) in and for said City in accordance with the written specifications and description and drawings prepared and submitted by the City Engineer provided said party making said proposal shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of this ordinance and all instruments herein referred to, which are made a part hereof.

Section 2. (Appropriation) That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises, the sum of Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Sanitary Sewer Fund derived from the sales of bonds of this City dated September 1, 1920, and said funds so appropriated shall be kept in a separate account to be designated as "Special Fund for constructing Bushnell Street Sanitary Sewer.

That the sum of Twenty Seven Dollars (\$27.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Widening Fund arising from the 1919 bond issue, warrant for which shall be drawn payable to the Texas Title Guaranty Company in payment of ~~guarant~~ guaranty No. 50837, covering title to a strip of land out of Lot A-1, City Block 145, acquired from Mrs A.M.Bishop for the purpose of widening Losoya Street, amounting to the sum of \$25.00, and recording fees on deed conveying said property to the City, amounting to \$2.00, as shown by statement hereto attached.
