FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 13TH, A.D.1918,

PRESENT:

Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, and Commissioners Lambert, Heuermann, Wright. Absent, Coy.

National Registration Day, having fallen on Sept. 12th, the Commissioners convened in regular session this 13th day of September at 10 O'clock a.m.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

AN ORDINANCE

Granting permit to W.H.Davis to construct sanitary sewer in Hammond Ave.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio,

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted W.H.Davis to construct an 8" sanitary sewer, beginning at City manhole Hammond and S.Pine, and extending east 75 feet, according to plat line and grade made by City Engineer hereto attached; the cost of said sewer being estimated about Eighty Five (\$85.00) Dollars to be paid by the said W.H.Davis. The final actual cost to be filed with the City Engineer within ten (10) days after the completion of the sewer.

Section. 2. Said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and part of its public sewer system.

Section 3. The City Engineer is hereby directed to collect the sum of Thirty Five Dollars for each and every connection made with said sewer main or house service going into said main and pay the same over to said W.H.Davis not later than the 10th of each month following the month in which said connection is made until the sum of Eighty Five (\$85.00) Dollars being the actual cost of said sewer shall have been collected and paid over as aforesaid, when no further connection fee of Thirty Five (\$35.00) shall be collected.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement between W.J.Lytle and W.F.Box, as party of the first part, and the City of San Antonio as party of the second part,

establishing an eight foot sidewalk over the new river line seperating the San Antonio River and City Block 403, between East Houston Street and East Travis Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of San Antonio, an agreement between W.J.Lytle and W.F.Box, as party of the first part, and said City of San Antonio as party of the second part, providing for the construction and erection of an eight foot walkway between East Houston and East Travis Streets along and upon the new established east river line seperating San Antonio River and City Block 403, a part of which shall be located on property belonging to the City of San Antonio and a part on property to be conveyed to the City of San Antonio by the said W.J.Lytle and W.F.Box, a copy of which said agreement is hereto attached and made a part hereof.

Petition of Otis Elevator Co. for permit to cut into sidewalk at Swearingen-McGraw building was granted, on recommendation of City Engineer.

Appropriating \$6500.00 acct paving Soledad Street, Houston to Romana Streets.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$6500.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay for the City of San Antonio's part of the paving of Soledad Street from Houston Street to Romana Street, this appropriation being made to substitute an equal amount appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund on March 17, 1918 under appropriation No. 175.
