

AN ORDINANCE 2013-02-07-0096

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE CHILD CARE SERVICES REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL MULTI-YEAR GRANT APPLICATION TO WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS ALAMO TO OPERATE THE CHILD CARE SERVICES PROGRAM BEGINNING FY 2014.

WHEREAS, the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) is responsible for administering the State's subsidized childcare program; and

WHEREAS, the TWC receives funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' (HHS) Child Care Development Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, the TWC determines the allocation for Child Care Services based on federal appropriations and local needs and contracts with Workforce Solutions Alamo (WSA), the local workforce development board, to implement the program; and

WHEREAS, the WSA provides funding for the childcare program and currently contracts with the City, through its Department of Human Services (DHS) to administer the Child Care Services (CCS) program in Bexar County and the 11 surrounding rural counties; and

WHEREAS, in FY 2013, the City received \$34,494,843.00 in CCS grant funds from WSA; and

WHEREAS, the total FY 2013 budget for CCS is \$45,999,604.00, which includes a delegate agency contract with the Alamo Area Development Corporation to provide childcare services to 11 rural counties in the Alamo Workforce Development area, matching funds from the FY 2013 DHS General Fund Operating Budget, and funds from the Texas Department of Family Protective Services to provide childcare for foster and abused children; and

WHEREAS, the CCS program provides subsidized childcare to eligible families based on their income and work or education activity, assisting a daily average of 8,600 children with childcare and averaging over 3,000 children on the CCS waiting list; and

WHEREAS, eligibility for the CCS program is based on the Federal Poverty Guidelines, including family size and income; and

WHEREAS, parents who receive a childcare subsidy must be working, in training, or attending college and enrolled in a demand occupation; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Human Services (DHS), or her designee, is hereby authorized to submit the Child Care Services multi-year grant application to Workforce Solutions Alamo to provide services beginning in FY 2014. If awarded, the City will operate Child Care Services for San Antonio and Bexar County. Approval to accept the award will be sought in a subsequent ordinance.

SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


