---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of employees in Government Reclamation Shops asking for better street car facilities, was read and referred to San Antonio Public Service Co.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation: Kuntz, Albaugh Lumber Co. for cancellation of taxes. and correction of assessment. A.P.Herff, for correction of assessment. V.A.Melcher, for correction of assessment.

On motion of Commissioner Heuermann, duly seconded and carried, the name of King William Street was ordered changed to Pershing Avenue.

MC-563 AN ORDINANCE

Accepting bid of Creosoted Materials Company to supply 3" wood block for repairs to street paving.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the bid of the Creosoted Materials Co., New Orleans, La. be accepted, agreeing to furnish 2000 sq. yds. 3" creosoted pine blocks at \$2.75 per sq. yd. F.O.B.San Antonio, for repairs to street paving on following streets:

E.Houston St. between Alamo Plaza and Chestnut.
Avenue C, between Travis St. and Grand Ave.
Taylor St. between Martin and Third Sts.
St. Mary St. between Travis St. & S.A.River, and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the sum of Fifty Five Hundred Dollars (\$5500.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay for 2000 sq. yds. of creosoted pine blocks per bid dated Sept 9, 1918, submitted by Creosoted Materials Co., New Orleans, La.


MC-565 AN ORDINANCE
