AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OUT OF LOT NO. 13, CITY BLOCK NO. 115, FROM JOSEPH COURAND NEEDED FOR THE WIDENING AND STRAIGHTENING OF EAST CROCKETT STREET, BETWEEN THE EAST LINE OF ALAMO PLAZA AND THE WEST LINE OF NACOGDOCHES STREET; AND THE SETTLEMENT OF DAMAGES TO IMPROVEMENTS AND THE REMAINING PROPERTY; AND APPROPRIATING MONEY TO PAY THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio has heretofore declared the existence of a public necessity for the widening and straightening of East Crockett Street between its intersection with the east line of Alamo Plaza and the west line of Nacogdoches Street, and as shown on map or plat on file in the office of the City Engineer; and has heretofore, on the 9th day of February, A. D. 1925, levied a special assessment on the front foot plan against the property owners of the property abutting on said Street, on account of the benefits accruing to said property by reason of the improvement of said Street; and

WHEREAS, a total assessment in the sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-one and 87/100 Dollars (\$2,631.87) was levied against the said Courand, and his said property, in Lot No. 13, Block No. 115, abutting on said Crockett Street, which said assessment the said Courand has agreed to pay; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with said plan of improvement, the City will require the hereinafter described strip of land out of Lot No. 13, City Block No. 115, lying between the present newly established north property line and the old north property line of said East Crockett street, which said strip of land the said Joseph Courand has agreed to convey to said City, and to release and accute unto said City and all claims which he has, or may have, for damages to the improvements, and to the remainder of his said property, by reason of such widening and improvement of said Street, for the sum of Nine Thousand Dollars, (\$9,000.00), and has agreed that the City may deduct from said sum the amount of the assessment against him and his said remaining property, leaving a balance of Six Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-eight and 13/100 Dollars (\$6,368.13) to be paid to the said Courand by said City;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to acquire by purchase from Joseph Courand all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Bexar County, Texas, fronting on East Crockett Street, within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, being a part of Lot Number Thirteen (No. 13), City Block Number One Hundred Fifteen (No. 115), embraced within the following field notes, viz:

BEGINNING at a point in the east property line of Alamo Plaza and the north property line of East Crockett Street;  
Thence in an easterly direction along the north property line of East Crockett Street, a distance of 106.9 feet to the east line of lot No. 13;  
Thence in a northerly direction along the division line of lots Nos.

12 and 13, a distance of 13.5 feet to the new established north property line of Crockett Street;

Thence in a westerly direction along the new established north property line of Crockett Street, a distance of 106.9 feet to the east property line of Alamo Plaza;

Thence in a southerly direction along the east property line of Alamo Plaza, a distance of 6.2 feet to the point of beginning, as shown on plat recorded in Record Book No. 6, page No. 94, in the City Engineer's Office;

For the total consideration of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00) which said amount includes the value of the land taken the damages sustained to the remaining property and improvements situated thereon, to be paid as follows:

The said Joseph Courand to be credited with the sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-one and 87/100 Dollars (\$2,631.87) in full payment of the special assessment against his said remaining property for benefits by reason of said widening improvements of said Crockett Street, and the sum of Six Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-eight and 13/100 Dollars (\$6,368.13) in cash, which said sum is hereby appropriated out of the 1924 street opening and widening fund; provided, that warrant for said \$6,368.13 shall not be delivered to said Courand unless and until good and sufficient warranty deed shall have been delivered to the Mayor.

SECTION TWO: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute a good and sufficient release of lien held by the City of San Antonio to secure the payment of said special assessment, created by the ordinance passed and approved on February 9, 1925; and to deliver the said release, upon execution and delivery of deed conveying the property mentioned in Section 1 hereof; and that assignable certificate of special assessment evidencing special assessment against said property and said Courand, if any such certificate has been issued, and all coupons thereof, are hereby ordered cancelled and surrendered upon compliance with the provisions herein contained.

DEDICATING A PORTION OF LOT 12, CITY BLOCK 115, FOR STREET PURPOSES AS PART OF EAST CROCKETT STREET BETWEEN ALAMO PLAZA AND NACOGDOCHES STREET.

WHEREAS, East Crockett Street (on its north side), between Alamo Plaza and Nacogdoches Street, in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, is being widened under the provisions of the "Improvement Ordinance", passed and approved on March 8, 1920, as amended on August 12, 1920, and subsequent amendments thereto, if any, and Chapter 11 of Title 22, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas for 1911, and by proper resolutions and ordinances of the City of San Antonio, it is proposed to take off of the southern portion of Lot 12, in City Block No. 115, owned by the City of San Antonio, and convert the same into the Street, and to be used for street purposes, the said portion so taken off and converted into the street being described as follows, to-wit;

Beginning at a point on the dividing line between Lots Nos 12 and 13, City Block 115, at the newly established north line of East Crockett Street, which is 13.5 feet north of the old line of said street, thence east along the newly established line of East Crockett Street 77 feet to a point on the west line of Nacogdoches Street, thence southwesterly and westerly along the old west line of Nacogdoches Street and old north line of East Crockett Street to the dividing line between said Lots Nos. 12 and 13, thence northerly along said dividing line 13.5 feet to the place of beginning; and

WHEREAS, the said tract of land so taken was valued at five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) in said proceedings, and the City given credit therefor, and said amount was included in the cost of making said improvement by the widening of said street; therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That, in consideration of the premises, the above described tract of land, so situated south of the newly established north line of East Crockett Street, be and the same is hereby set apart and dedicated for street purposes and as part of said East Crockett Street.

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY ON SOUTH FLORES STREET NOT NECESSARY FOR ITS WIDENING TO N. KALLISON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That John W. Tobin, Mayor of said City of San Antonio, be and he is hereby authorized to sell and convey by deed, a tract of land out of Lots Nos. Eight (8), Nine (9) and Ten (10), City Block No. One Hundred and Eleven (111), and a tract of land out of Lots Nos. One (1), Three (3), Four (4) and Five (5), City Block No. One Hundred and Eleven (111), and a tract of land out of Lot No. A-Eleven (A-11), City Block No. One Hundred and Eleven (111), on the west side of South Flores Street, to Nathan Kallison, for Twenty-three Thousand (\$23,000.00) Dollars cash.
