An invitation from Fiesta San Jacinto Association to participate in the Flower Battle Parade was read and accepted.

Petition of C. Jacobs for change in Jitney Route was read and referred to City Attorney.

Commissioner Garland submitted the monthly report of the City Auditor, which was adopted and ordered filed.

Petition of Church of God in Christ for permit to build a church at Iowa and Mesquite Streets, was granted, subject to approval of City Building Inspector.

The following ordinance was introduced and read, and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Brown, Garland, Lambert and Kearny. Nays, none. Absent, Uhr.
