No. 335 **MC-751** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$5199.58 to pay S.A.Machine and Supply Company, and DeCarie Incinerator Company on second unit of Incinerator Plant.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$5199.58 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Garbage Incinerator Fund to pay San Antonio Machine and Supply Company, and DeCarie Incinerator Co., third estimate on second unit of the Garbage Incinerator Plant, as per City Engineers Statement filed in the office of the City Auditor.

No. 336 **- 752** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$2258.61 to pay McGill Construction Company for repairs made to certain streets.

No. 327 **MC-753** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$32.40 out of the 1918 General Fund, to pay Wm. Paul Schultze on account of injuries to motorcycle.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Thirty-two and 40/100 (\$32.40) Dollars be and the sum is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Wm. Paul Schultze for injuries received to his motor cycle caused by a water pipe sticking up out of South Flores Street, while the said Wm. Paul Schultze was on an errand to the Chief of Police on January 16th, 1919.

No. 339 **-755** AN ORDINANCE

No. 342 **-758** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$125.00 to pay R.A.Arthur for service rendered as appraiser of property.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$125.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay R.A.Arthur for services rendered as an appraiser of realty property, for the Commissioner of Taxation, during the month of January, 1919.

AN ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, under the provisions of ordinance duly authorizing the same, performed certain work in the way of clearing and grubbing certain lots and blocks of land belonging to Mrs Callie M. Metzger; and

WHEREAS, the City has filed liens against said lots to secure payment of said work; and

WHEREAS, it seems advisable to facilitate the settlement of said claim to accept a sum ~~of~~ smaller than claimed to be due therefor;

Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the Mayor, upon receipt of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars is hereby authorized to execute a full and complete release to the owner of said lots and blocks for all claims that the City has or may have by reason of said liens.


That petition of Mt Zion Baptist Church for remission of taxes be granted. Adopted.
