

AN ORDINANCE      2010-12-16-1097

**AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF BULVERDE ROAD TO  
“AUTRY POND ROAD” BETWEEN THE INTERSECTION OF  
BULVERDE ROAD AT CLASSEN ROAD AND THE EXISTING  
BULVERDE ROAD NORTH OF REDLAND ROAD AT THE POINT OF  
THE SOUTHERN END OF THE BULVERDE ROAD REALIGNMENT.**

*WHEREAS*, in 2009, the property owner at Bulverde Road south of Loop 1604 proposed and were approved for a realignment of Bulverde Road south of Loop 1604 to Redland Road. This realignment and improvement of Bulverde Road provided a more direct path of travel to access areas south of the proposed commercial complex. The change required the renaming of the existing original section of Bulverde Road so as to eliminate public confusion, reduce the current public safety concerns, and enhance public traffic flow; and

*WHEREAS*, during the public hearing in April of 2009, the proposed name, “Catherine Path” was considered and forwarded to City Council for final approval. However, a member of the Autry family, who is a property owner adjacent to the proposed renamed roadway, asked that consideration be given to rename the road after the family instead. The item was presented to City Council for consideration on April 16, 2009. Due to further investigation subsequent to the public hearing and presentation of deed documents suggesting that the family donated the land proposed for redevelopment along this portion of Bulverde Road, Councilman Clamp pulled the item from City Council review. Shortly thereafter, the project’s developer rescinded their request to rename this section of Bulverde Road to “Catherine Path” and sold the property to the current owner; and

*WHEREAS*, the current owner and Councilman Clamp’s Office representing Council District 10 have worked with representatives of the Autry family and agreed to rename Bulverde Road as Autry Pond Road between the intersection of Bulverde Road at Classen Road and the existing Bulverde Road north of Redland Road at the point of the southern end of the Bulverde Road realignment; and

*WHEREAS*, notice of said proposal was disseminated through public service announcements and postings at City Hall, Council believes that the purpose for and input provided by the City Code procedures for renaming streets has been satisfied; **NOW THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The city-owned street known as Bulverde Road in City Council District 10 between the intersection of Bulverde Road at Classen Road and the existing Bulverde Road north of Redland Road at the point of the southern end of the Bulverde realignment is hereby renamed “Autry Pond Road.” A map is attached as Exhibit 1 to identify the section of road to be renamed. City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

**SECTION 2.** There is no financial impact realized through the passage of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall be effective on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2010.




