

AN ORDINANCE **50602**

DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF
THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD THE 7TH DAY OF
APRIL, 1979, IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,
AND ORDERING A RUN-OFF ELECTION TO BE HELD
THE 21ST DAY OF APRIL, 1979.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the regular municipal election was held on the 7th day of April, 1979, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio for the ensuing term of office of two years; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates were submitted, the election was held and conducted and the returns thereof were made, all as required by the City Charter, the laws of the State of Texas, the proclamation of the Mayor and the law for such cases made and decided; and

WHEREAS, the City Council met on April 9, 1979, in the Council Chamber at City Hall to canvass the returns of said election; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council having convened April 9, 1979, to canvass the returns of the regular City election held April 7, 1979, after canvassing the returns of said election, the City Council does hereby find and declare the result of the election to be as follows:

SECTION 2. It is further declared that as a result of said election, the following persons were elected Council Members for a two-year term commencing May 1, 1979:

- Henry G. Cisneros, Member of Council, Place No. 1
- Joe Webb, Member of Council, Place No. 2
- Frank D. Wing, Member of Council, Place No. 4
- Bernardo Eureste, Member of Council, Place No. 5
- Joe Alderete, Jr., Member of Council, Place No. 7
- Gene Canavan, Member of Council, Place No. 8
- Van Archer, Member of Council, Place No. 9
- John Steen, Member of Council, Place No. 10
- Lila Cockrell, Member of Council, Place No. 11 (MAYOR)

and each of them was elected by receiving a majority of all the votes cast for the office for which each was a candidate cast by the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio voting at said election, and they and each of them are hereby declared to be the lawful and duly elected Council Members of the City for the places specified.

SECTION 3. It is further declared that as a result of said election, no candidate for Place No. 3 received a majority of all the votes for the office for which he was a candidate cast by the qualified voters of the City voting in said election, and therefore, no candidate was elected at said election for the office of Member of Council for Place No. 3, but that a second or run-off election will be necessary in order that the candidate receiving the highest number of votes shall have received a majority of all the votes cast for the office for which he was a candidate, and said run-off election is hereby ordered to be held on April 21, 1979. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for such place in the election shall again be voted for at the second or run-off election.

SECTION 4. This canvass did not include the District 6 Council election for Member of City Council, Place No. 6, and no declaration is made relative thereto, pending a recheck and comparison of the vote cast, as requested by Mr. Rudy Ortiz, candidate, which recount is hereby authorized.

SECTION 5. Payment of all expenses incurred in connection with the holding of said election and run-off election is hereby authorized to be made out of the General Fund.


Dear Mr. Jackson:

APPLICATION

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Now comes Garland V. Jackson, Jr., the duly appointed, authorized and acting City Clerk of the City of San Antonio, and here and now petitions the Presiding Judge of the District Court of Bexar County to enter an order on the minutes of this District Court authorizing and directing that each and all of the voting machines used in the April 7, 1979, City of San Antonio election except those containing votes for Councilman, District 6, be cleared of all totals shown thereon and the counters of said machines be set at zero, so that said voting machines may be prepared and inspected for use in the City runoff election on April 21, 1979, pursuant to Art. 7.16 of the Election Code and Section 25 of the City Charter of the City of San Antonio.

In support of the petition and order requested in the above and foregoing paragraph, the following facts are set forth for the knowledge of the Court:

(a). Heretofore, to wit, on the 7th day of April 1979, pursuant to Article 2.01b(a) of the Election Code, a General City Election was held in the City of San Antonio for the offices of Councilman, District 1; Councilman, District 2; Councilman, District 3; Councilman, District 4; Councilman, District 5; Councilman, District 6; Councilman, District 7; Councilman, District 8; Councilman, District 9; Councilman, District 10; and Mayor, which election was held by the use of voting machines in accordance with an ordinance of the City of San Antonio duly passed and approved.

(b). The City Council of the City of San Antonio has duly and regularly canvassed the returns of said election, and by ordinance, a certified copy of which is marked Exhibit "A" and attached hereto and made a part hereof, has declared the results of said election, except as to Councilman, District 6, in which a recount is to be made.


(c). It is desired to use voting machines as the legal and lawful method of voting in said runoff election to be held in the City of San Antonio on the 21st day of April, 1979, but it will be impractical to hold said election by means of voting machines unless the order applied for is granted because Bexar County, the owner of said machines owns and possesses only a limited number of voting machines of the type used in said City election of April 7, 1979, which machines now contain the total vote cast upon said machines in said election.

(d). Under the provisions of Article 2.01b(c), said runoff election must be held on April 21, 1979, following the issuance of a call for said election, and that, therefore, if the voting machines used in said City election of April 7, 1979, are not cleared, except those containing votes for Councilman, District 6, it will be physically impossible to prepare a sufficient number of said machines for use and to use same in the runoff election to be held in the City of San Antonio on the 21st day of April, 1979.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, your petitioner prays the Court to issue an order instanter, ordering and directing that said machines except those containing votes for Councilman, District 6, be cleared of all of the totals shown thereon and said machines thus be prepared so that they may be used by the electorate of the City of San Antonio in the runoff election to be held on April 21, 1979, and your petitioner further prays that all such further orders or relief as he may be entitled to, in law or in equity, which will effectuate the purpose of the application.


