

AN ORDINANCE

DECLARING THE CANVASSING AND THE RESULT OF RUN-OFF MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON THE 25TH DAY OF MAY, 1943.

\* \* \*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. Came on this 26th day of May, A.D. 1943, regularly to be canvassed the returns of the run-off municipal election held on the 25th day of May, 1943, to determine the Commissioner of Taxation of the City of San Antonio under the Charter for the ensuing term of office of two years;

2. And the Mayor and Commissioners having met to canvass the returns and to declare the result of said election in the manner provided by law, and after considering, determining and canvassing all matters of fact appertaining, we, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, do hereby find and declare the result of the said run-off election to be as tabulated as follows:-

FOR COMMISSIONER OF TAXATION:

"FOR" ALFRED CALLAGHAN . . . . . 6,303 votes
"FOR" CHARLES M. MURPHY . . . . . 733 votes

3. And it appearing to the Mayor and Commissioners that the names of the candidates were submitted, and that the run-off election was held and conducted, and that the returns thereof were made, all as required by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, the laws of the State of Texas, the proclamation of the Mayor and the law for such cases made and provided, and that at said run-off election there was cast respectively for each of said candidates, the aggregate number of votes "FOR", all as shown by the report.

4. And the Mayor and Commissioners having first canvassed said returns and said reports and having found the same in all things correct, the same was thereupon adopted by the unanimous vote of the Mayor and Commissioners; and it is further declared that as the result of said run-off election, the Commissioner of Taxation of the City of San Antonio for the two years following the 1st day of June, A.D. 1943, is Alfred Callaghan, and that he was elected by receiving a majority of all the votes cast for the office for which he was a candidate cast by the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio voting at said run-off election, and he is hereby declared to be the lawful and duly elected Commissioner of Taxation of the City of San Antonio.

5. PASSED AND APPROVED this 26th day of May, A.D. 1943.
