

AN ORDINANCE 2008-08-14-0702

**APPROPRIATING \$25,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 5 NEIGHBORHOOD ACCESSIBILITY MOBILITY PROGRAM AND \$25,000.00 FROM THE OFFICE OF CULTURAL AFFAIR'S CULTURAL COLLABORATIVE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PUBLIC ART PROJECT IN ELMENDORF LAKE PARK, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 5, AN AUTHORIZED 2007-2012 BOND PROGRAM PROJECT.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Capital Improvement Management Services Department is in coordination with the Parks and Recreation Department in managing the Elmendorf Lake Park Project to restore a concrete stage and boat dock and to provide Americans with disabilities accessibility within the park area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Art Division in the Capital Improvement Management Services Department will provide recommendations for developing a commemorative piece of artwork that will be inspired by the heroic contribution made by the City's Hispanic veteran community; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilwoman Galvan is designating \$25,000 from the District 5 Neighborhood Accessibility Mobility Program and \$25,000.00 from the Office of Cultural Affairs Appropriations for "The Cultural Collaborative"; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance will authorize the use of a portion of the NAMP Funds to raise additional funds for the project, and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 for artwork to be placed in Elmendorf Lake Park; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The amount of \$50,000.00 is hereby appropriated for development of artwork in Elmendorf Lake Park and a portion of the NAMP Funds may be used for fund raising activities related to this public art project.

**SECTION 2.** The following financial adjustments are hereby authorized to effect this Ordinance:

- a) The appropriation in the amount of \$25,000.00 is reduced for this ordinance in Fund 29006000, Hotel Motel Tax Fund, Fund Center 2801010000, Functional Area 990001280001, General Ledger 5201040 and the FY08 budget is amended to reflect this change.

- b) The amount of \$25,000.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 29006000, Hotel Motel Tax Fund, SAP Internal Order # 390000000695, SAP GL account 6102100 – Interfund Transfer out entitled From 29006000 to WBS 40-00080-90-02. The amount of \$25,000.00 is authorized to be transferred to SAP Fund 45099000.
- c) The appropriation in the amount of \$25,000.00 is reduced for this ordinance in Fund 29050000, Streets/Drainage Maintenance and Improvements, Fund Center 2303050000, Functional Area 230100000005, General Ledger 5301010 and the FY08 budget is amended to reflect this change
- d) The amount of \$25,000.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 29050000, Streets/Drainage Maintenance and Improvements, SAP Internal Order # 390000000696, SAP GL account 6102100 – Interfund Transfer out entitled From 29050000 to WBS 40-00080-90-03. The amount of \$25,000.00 is authorized to be transferred to SAP Fund 45099000.
- e) The budget in fund 45099000, SAP Project Definition 40-00180, Elmendorf Lake Park, shall be revised by increasing SAP WBS Element 40-00080-90-02 entitled Trf Fr I/O# 390000000695, SAP GL Account 6101100 – Interfund Transfer In, by the amount \$25,000.00.
- f) The budget in fund 45099000, SAP Project Definition 40-00180, Elmendorf Lake Park, shall be revised by increasing SAP WBS Element 40-00080-90-03 entitled Trf Fr I/O# 390000000696, SAP GL Account 6101100 – Interfund Transfer In, by the amount \$25,000.00.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day after passage.

Elmendorf Lake Park Public Art Project

**SUMMARY:**

An ordinance appropriating \$25,000.00 from the District 5 Neighborhood Accessibility Mobility Program and \$25,000.00 from the Office of Cultural Affairs Cultural Collaborative for the development of a Public Art Project in Elmendorf Lake Park.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Councilwoman Lourdes Galvan approached the Public Art Division in the Capital Improvement Management Services (CIMS) Department to provide recommendations for developing a commemorative artwork inspired by the heroic contributions of San Antonio's Hispanic veteran community. Additionally, the CIMS department, in coordination with the Parks and Recreation Department, is managing the Elmendorf Lake Park Project, a 2007-2012 Bond Program project, that would restore a concrete stage and boat dock and provide Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility within the park area.

Working with City staff, and in accordance with City's policies and guidelines for public art, an Artist Selection Panel was convened on May 22, 2008 to review the project and identify an appropriate artist to design a proposed artwork for Elmendorf Lake Park that would pay tribute to the community's veterans. Community representation on the Artist Selection Panel included members of Veterans of Foreign Wars organizations, League of United Latin American Citizens, City Council District 5, City of San Antonio Public Art Committee, and CIMS and Parks and Recreation Department staff. By unanimous approval, and by utilizing the method of direct selection, the panel selected the acclaimed local artist Jesse Trevino to develop art concepts and proposed budget for the project.

Mr. Trevino's initial design proposal was presented and reviewed by the City's Public Art Committee on July 25, 2008. The committee expressed their encouragement and stated their

support for the project, in addition to providing the artist their input prior to bringing the project back for conceptual design approval.

**ISSUE:**

This ordinance authorizes funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 for an artwork in Elmendorf Lake Park in Council District Five. Councilwoman Galvan is designating \$25,000.00 from the District 5 Neighborhood Accessibility Mobility Program. The remaining \$25,000.00 will come from the Office of Cultural Affairs appropriations for "The Cultural Collaborative". On Thursday, July 24, 2008, The Cultural Collaborative Implementation Committee approved the recommendation for the utilization of funds in support of this project.

Additional funding for the project will come from private fundraising efforts.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

If Council does not approve this ordinance, other funding sources would need to be identified to move forward with this project.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This project is being funded with \$50,000.00 appropriated by the District 5 Neighborhood Accessibility Mobility Program (NAMP) and by Office of Cultural Affairs allocations for "The Cultural Collaborative", with equal contributions of \$25,000.00. NAMP can only be utilized if the project is done in conjunction with the Capital Improvements Project (CIP) Parks Project.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of the appropriation of funds for the Public Art Project for the Elemendorf Lake Park Project.
