The meeting was called to order at 6:45 P.M., by the presiding officer, Mayor Lila Cockrell, with the following members present: CISNEROS, WEBB, DUTMER, WING, EURESTE, THOMPSON, ALDERETE, CANAVAN, ARCHER, COCKRELL; Absent: STEEN.

81-19 Mayor Cockrell explained that the Special Meeting had been called to consider a Resolution. She asked that the City Clerk read the caption.

The Clerk then read the following Resolution:

A RESOLUTION
NO. 81-19-40

REQUESTING VARIOUS ELECTED OFFICIALS
TO SUPPORT THE CONTINUATION OF THE
HUMAN SERVICES PROGRAM AND PRESERVA-
TION OF EXISTING SOCIAL SERVICES
PROGRAMS FUNDED BY THE FEDERAL
GOVERNMENT.

Dr. Cisneros moved to approve the Resolution. Mr. Webb seconded the motion.

Mayor Cockrell then called on Mr. Wade Firmin who was registered to speak on this item.

Mr. Wade Firmin stated that he could understand the frustrations and the concerns expressed by those citizens who had spoken to the issue during the Citizens to be Heard session at the Regular Meeting, however he felt that there were community leaders who were becoming part of the problem.

After consideration, the motion to approve the Resolution prevailed by the following vote: AYES: Cisneros, Webb, Dutmer, Wing, Eureste, Thompson, Alderete, Cockrell; NAYS: Canavan, Archer; ABSENT: Steen.
