

AN ORDINANCE 2015-01-08-0008

**APPROVING “DORIS GRIFFIN SENIOR ONE STOP CENTER” AS THE NAME OF THE DISTRICT 7 SENIOR COMPREHENSIVE CENTER LOCATED AT 6157 NW LOOP 410.**

**WHEREAS**, the District 7 Senior Comprehensive Center, located at 6157 NW Loop 410, will offer a variety of social services for seniors age 60 and older, including congregate meals, computer classes, exercise, dance, recreational activities, art and health-related services, and will be the City’s eighth senior multi-purpose center; and

**WHEREAS**, the name “Doris Griffin Senior One Stop Center” was proposed as Doris Griffin is a longtime Council District 7 resident and advocate for senior issues, and a member of the Texas Silver-Haired Legislature and Alamo Area Council of Governments – Bexar Senior Advisory Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Griffin also serves as the executive director of the non-profit Jefferson Outreach, which is dedicated to the betterment of seniors’ quality of life through services that help them remain living at home; and

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the City Code, the proposed name was forwarded to the City Clerk and considered by a Naming Committee at a public hearing on December 10, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the Naming Committee consisted of Melody Woosley, Department of Human Services Director; Carol Zernial, WellMed Charitable Foundation Executive Director, and Alicia Treviño Rodriguez and Jesse Cardenas, District 7 Community Representatives; and

**WHEREAS**, during the meeting, the Naming Committee approved recommending the “Doris Griffin Senior One Stop Center” as the name for City Council consideration and approval; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The name “Doris Griffin Senior One Stop Center” is hereby adopted as the name of the District 7 Senior Comprehensive Center located at 6157 NW Loop 410, as recommended by the convened Naming Committee.




**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
