

A RESOLUTION

DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE COUNCIL TO SUBMIT ORDINANCE 34267 ENACTED APRIL 7, 1966, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE FLUORIDATION OF THE CITY'S PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM, TO THE ELECTORS AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY AND THE CITY CLERK TO TAKE SUCH STEPS AS ARE NECESSARY IN ORDER THAT THE COUNCIL MAY ADOPT AN ORDINANCE AT ITS NEXT REGULAR MEETING CALLING SUCH REFERENDUM ELECTION NOT LESS THAN 30 NOR MORE THAN 90 DAYS FROM THIS DATE.

Whereas, Ordinance 34267 was passed and approved April 7, 1966, authorizing and instructing the Water Works Board of Trustees of the City of Snn Antonio to proceed with the fluoridation of the City's public water supply system; and,

Whereas, a petition was filed with the City Clerk on May 16, 1966, requesting that the aforementioned ordinance be either repealed or submitted to a vote of the electors, and the City Clerk has determined that said petition was signed by a sufficient number of qualified electors and that it bore proper statements of the circulators; and,

Whereas, on this date the City Council has voted in the negative on the question "Shall the ordinance be repealed?" pursuant to Section 40 of the City Charter; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

The City Attorney and the City Clerk are hereby directed to take the necessary steps in order that the Council may adopt an ordinance at its next regular meeting calling for an election at which the aforementioned referred ordinance shall be submitted to the electors at a municipal election not less than 30 nor more than 90 days from this date pursuant to Section 41 of the City Charter.
