AN ORDINANCE **60059**

ORDERING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 6TH DAY OF APRIL, 1985, IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS ON PROPOSED BOND ISSUES FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS, DRAINAGE, POLICE PROTECTION, FIRE PROTECTION, AND LIBRARY SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS FOR A TOTAL OF \$100,325,000.00; ENUMERATING THE BOND PROJECTS AND STATING THE CITY COUNCIL'S COMMITMENT THAT THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH BONDS WILL BE EXPENDED FOR SUCH PROJECTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. That a bond election be, and the same is ordered hereby to be held on Saturday, the 6th day of April, A.D., 1985, in accordance with the laws of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, and the official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code and at said election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$39,235,000.00 with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially or otherwise within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates (fixed, floating, or variable), not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law at the time of issuance of the bonds, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for permanent public improvements, to wit: street improvements, including curbs, gutters, drainage, and other improvements incidental thereto and land acquisition therefor (including but not limited to the following projects:

Martin/Bowie Street Connection - Houston to Broadway
Lombrano - General McMullen to Martinez Creek
Elmendorf - Culebra to Cincinnati

and shall said City Council be authorized to levy, and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$50,890,000.00 with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially or otherwise within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates (fixed, floating, or variable), not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law at the time of issuance of the bonds, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for permanent public improvements, to wit: drainage and flood control, including facilities incident and related thereto and acquisition of land and right-of-way therefor (including but not limited to the following projects:

and shall said City Council be authorized to levy, and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 3

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$4,200,000, with the bonds of each series or issue to mature serially or otherwise within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates (fixed, floating, or variable), not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law at the time of issuance of the bonds, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for permanent public improvements, to wit: constructing and equipping police substation facilities including acquisition of land therefor (to include two police substations to be located in the vicinity of (i) Martin Luther King and IH 10 and (ii) Zarzamora and S.W. Military Drive)

and shall said City Council be authorized to levy, and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 4

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$3,000,000, with the bonds of each series or issue to mature serially or otherwise within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates (fixed, floating, or variable), not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law at the time of issuance of the bonds, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for permanent public improvements and public purposes, to wit: constructing and equipping fire station facilities including acquisition of land therefor, (to include three fire stations to be located in the vicinity of (i) Prue Road and Babcock Road, (ii) General McMullen and Commerce, and (iii) Benrus Road and Culebra Road)

and shall said City Council be authorized to levy, and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 5

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$3,000,000, with the bonds of each series or issue to mature serially or otherwise within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates (fixed, floating, or variable), not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law at the time of issuance of the bonds, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for permanent public improvements, to wit: library facilities, including acquisition of land therefor (to include two branch libraries to be located in the vicinity of (i) Thousand Oaks and El Sendero and (ii) Ingram Road and Callaghan, and to include renovations and improvements to facilities in the Central Business District)

and shall said City Council be authorized to levy, and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

SECTION 2. The official ballots for such election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid propositions, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings, and language as required by law, and with such propositions to be expressed substantially as follows:

SECTION 3. Said election shall be held as prescribed by law, in the City of San Antonio at the following polling or voting places in the several precincts of the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M.:

SECTION 4. Voting at said election shall be done by the use of voting machines or paper ballots as determined by the City Clerk, and the City Council of the City of San Antonio does determine hereby that voting machines or paper ballot shall be used for the casting of absentee votes at this election, and voting machines shall be placed in the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas and at temporary branch offices (Attachment II) established for the purpose of conducting absentee voting by personal appearance. The City Clerk, or any Assistant City Clerk, is authorized and charged to perform the functions provided by law in the casting of absentee ballots and shall hold such election, and ballots shall be cast commencing March 18, 1985, and ending April 2, 1985; all in the method, manner and time made and provided by the Statutes of the State of Texas on this subject.

SECTION 5. The Mayor shall appoint the election officers to hold said election, in accordance with law, including a special canvassing board which shall count the absentee ballots cast at said election.

SECTION 6. Notice of said bond election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Ordinance at three (3) public places in the City of San Antonio and also at the City Hall, not less than 15 days prior to the date set for said election; and a substantial copy of this Ordinance also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio, the date of the first publication to be not less than 14 days prior to the date set for said election.

SECTION 7. All bonds voted at said election shall be issued only in accordance with, and subject to all restrictions and requirements of, all applicable law.

SECTION 8. All residents, qualified electors of the City of San Antonio shall be entitled to vote at said election.

SECTION 9. The City Council of the City of San Antonio hereby commits that the proceeds of the bonds shall be used first to accomplish the projects identified in the respective propositions above, and, to the extent funds are available, for other authorized projects as approved by the City Council.
