PRESENT: Honorable C. M. Chambers, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright.


The Mayor announced that this Special Meeting had been called for the purpose of acting on the petition of the Associated Sanitary Engineers, requesting the removal from office of E. L. Haenig, Plumbing Inspector of the City of San Antonio.

Whereupon Bruce W. Teagarden, Counsel for E. G. Haenig Plumbing Inspector, announced that he had, up to this time not been able to prepare his answer to the charges, for the reason that the same had been filed at 3:300 o'clock p. m. on May 17th, 1928, and suggested that the matter under consideration be postponed to a later date.


