AN ORDINANCE

BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULT OF AN ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF \$9,000,000.00 STREET CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT BONDS.

* * * *

WHEREAS, heretofore, on June 2, 1960, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, passed an ordinance calling for an election to be held in said City on June 28, 1960, on the following proposition:

"Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$9,000,000.00 maturing serially in such installments as the City Council may prescribe, the maximum maturity being not more than 30 years from their date, bearing interest at a rate not to exceed 5% per annum, and to levy a tax on all taxable property within said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity, for the purpose of building, grading, paving, curbing, improving and extending the streets of said City as authorized by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, and the Charter of said City?"

WHEREAS, said election was duly held at the time and places specified after due notice as required by law had been given by posting and publication; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and legally held on the 28th day of June, 1960, in conformity with the election ordinance heretofore passed by the City Council, and the result of said election has been certified and returned to this Council by the proper judges and clerks of said election; and

WHEREAS, the Council has this day considered the returns of said election on the proposition of said election hereinabove stated; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council and the Council so finds that said election was in all respects lawfully held and said returns duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election the following votes:

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF STREET CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT BONDS"	<u>18429</u> Votes;
"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF STREET CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT BONDS"	<u>18758</u> Votes;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. The proposition of the issuance of \$9,000,000.00 Street Construction and Improvement Bonds was not approved by a majority of the resident qualified electors who own taxable property in the City of San Antonio, Texas, and who have duly rendered same for taxation who voted in said election.

AN ORDINANCE

PROVIDING THAT ALL PERSONS RESIDING IN THAT PORTION OF VOTING PRECINCT 92, NOW WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, SHALL VOTE AT THE POLLING PLACE DESIGNATED FOR PRECINCT 91 IN THE BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO ON JUNE 28, 1960; AND PROVIDING THAT ALL PERSONS RESIDING IN THAT PORTION OF PRECINCT 104, NOW WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO SHALL VOTE AT THE POLLING PLACE DESIGNATED FOR PRECINCT 135 IN THE BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO ON JUNE 28, 1960.

WHEREAS, as more fully appears by reference to the minutes of the County Commissioners of Bexar County, Texas, on the 14th day of August, 1946, the 14th day of August, 1947, the 12th day of August, 1948, the 10th day of August, 1949, the 19th day of August, 1950, the 18th day of August, 1951, the 18th day of August, 1952, the 14th day of August, 1953, the 9th day of August, 1954, the 11th day of August, 1955, the 17th day of August, 1956, the 14th day of August, 1957, the 15th day of August, 1958, and the 14th day of August, 1959, the County Commissioners, acting by the authority vested in them by Article 2934, Chapter 2, Title 50, and Article 2997a, Sec. 5, Chapter 6, Title 50, Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, revised, established and corrected voting precincts within the City of San Antonio; and,

WHEREAS, in so establishing, revising and correcting voting precincts within the City of San Antonio, the County Commissioners were guided by the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio as they then existed; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council duly adopted voting precincts within the City of San Antonio as so revised, established and corrected by said County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, subsequent to such action of the County Commissioners, the City of San Antonio duly annexed certain territory which comprised a part of Precinct 92 and a part of Precinct 104 as so established, revised and corrected, so that Precincts 92 and 104, which were formerly without the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, are now partially within the corporate limits of said City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, by ordinance passed and approved on June 2, 1960, duly called an election to be held within the City of San Antonio on June 28, 1960, on the question of issuing \$9,000,000.00 in Street Construction and Improvement Bonds; and,

WHEREAS, in setting forth the polling places for said election, said ordinance made no provision for qualified electors residing in that portion of Precincts 92 and 104 which are now within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council is anxious to insure that the qualified electors residing in the portions of said precincts now within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio be given an opportunity to vote in said bond election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:—

1. All resident qualified electors of the City of San Antonio, Texas, who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered same for taxation, residing in that portion of Voting Precinct No. 92 which is now within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, shall be entitled to vote in the bond election to be held in said City on June 28, 1960, on the question of the issuance of \$9,000,000.00 in Street Construction and Improvement Bonds (said election having been duly called by Ordinance No. 28, 523, adopted June 2, 1960), and shall cast their ballots at the polling place designated and provided for Voting Precinct No. 91.

2. All resident qualified electors of the City of San Antonio, Texas, who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered same for taxation, residing in that portion of Voting Precinct No. 104 which is now within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, shall be entitled to vote in the bond election to be held in said City on June 28, 1960, on the question of the issuance of \$9,000,000.00 in Street Construction and Improvement Bonds (said election having been duly called by Ordinance No. 28, 523, adopted June 2, 1960), and shall cast their ballots at the polling place designated and provided for Voting Precinct No. 135.

3. The City Clerk is directed to publish and post copies of this ordinance as specified in Paragraph 5 of said Ordinance No. 28, 523, and to take such other measures as may be proper to the end that all persons residing in the aforementioned portions of Precincts 92 and 104 which are now within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio shall be fully informed of their rights hereunder.

4. An emergency exists for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, welfare, and safety, requiring that this ordinance become effective immediately, therefore, upon passage, this ordinance by an affirmative vote of six (6) members of the City Council, shall be effective from and after the date of its passage as provided by the Charter of the City of San Antonio.


