
Appropriating \$118.42 out of the 1919 General Fund to pay Felix Heerman for broom corn sold by the City of San Antonio.


Commissioner Lambert recommended that petition of Acme Advertizing Co. for permit to place trash cans upon streets of the City be not granted. Adopted.
