

AN ORDINANCE

2008 - 03 - 06 - 0160

AWARDING CONTRACTS TO VARIOUS COMPANIES TO PROVIDE THE CITY WITH VARIOUS TYPES OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES ON AN ANNUAL CONTRACT BASIS FOR FY 2007-2008, FOR A COMBINED ANNUAL ESTIMATED COST OF \$1,133,000.00, AND AWARDING ONE CONTRACT WHICH WILL PROVIDE AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL REVENUE TO THE CITY OF \$34,000.00, INCLUDING: (A) DRILLING WOOD AND STEEL POLE FOUNDATIONS - \$113,000.00 ANNUALLY; (B) LABOR AND MATERIAL FOR CONCRETE WORK FOR PARK OPERATIONS - \$60,000.00 ANNUALLY; (C) MOWING SERVICES IN PUBLIC PARK AREAS AND OTHER CITY PROPERTY - \$960,000.00 ANNUALLY; AND (D) RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL OF AUTOMOTIVE AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT OIL & OIL FILTERS - \$34,000.00 ANNUALLY IN REVENUE.

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WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, this group of contracts represents a portion of approximately two hundred and fifty (250) annual contracts that will be brought before City Council throughout the remainder of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, these bids are from various companies to furnish the City with: drilling wood and steel pole foundations; labor and material for concrete work for Park Operations; mowing services in public park areas and other City property; and recycling and disposal of automotive and heavy equipment oil & oil filters; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves 2 low bid contracts, and 3 contracts procured on the basis of requests for proposals; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the 2007-2008 budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bids and offers of various companies to furnish the City with: drilling wood and steel pole foundations; labor and material for concrete work for Park Operations; mowing services in public park areas and other City property; and recycling and disposal of automotive and heavy equipment oil & oil filters are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit I. Copies of the contracts are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing & Contract

Services Department. The City Manager, her designee, the Director of the Purchasing & Contract Services Department, or her designee, are all hereby authorized to execute the contracts for Mowing Services and Oil and Oil Filter Recycling, in substantially the form as attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibits II and III, respectively.

SECTION 2. The amounts will be encumbered upon issuance of various purchase orders, and payment is authorized to various vendors. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY 2007-2008 budget approved by City Council. The combined estimated total expenditure for contracts listed on this ordinance is approximately \$1,133,000.00.




SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect March 16, 2008.


