

AN ORDINANCE 2012-08-30-0660

**ADOPTING “DR. MANUEL P. BERRIOZÁBAL CAFÉCOLLEGE” AS THE NEW NAME OF CAFÉ COLLEGE, THE CITY’S COLLEGE ACCESS CENTER AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CONVENEED NAMING COMMITTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY’S CODE REGULATING NAMING CITY FACILITIES.**

**WHEREAS**, Café College is a comprehensive resource and assistance center and offers residents support in selecting, preparing, and applying for post-secondary education opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, services provided at Café College include college recruiting, college counseling, Scholastic Aptitude Test/American College Testing preparation, assistance in completing the Federal Student Aid forms, assistance securing scholarships and financial aid and web-based access to services; and

**WHEREAS**, Café College is on pace to serve over 20,000 students and families seeking college access/advisory services this year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is seeking to increase attainment of college degrees and to create a new generation of highly educated and highly skilled members of the San Antonio workforce; and

**WHEREAS**, to create a better and more dynamic San Antonio workforce, a new City direction is to promote careers in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics; and

**WHEREAS**, a proposal to rename Café College to “Dr. Manuel P. Berriozábal cafécollege” was submitted as Dr. Berriozábal served as an early and long lasting proponent of careers in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) and would serve to exemplify the opportunities that a STEM education can provide the residents of San Antonio; and

**WHEREAS**, for over 30 years, Dr. Manuel P. Berriozábal worked to prepare minority junior high and high school students for careers in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) through the San Antonio Prefreshman Engineering Program (TexPREP) established at the University of Texas at San Antonio; and

**WHEREAS**, today, PREP has become a statewide outreach initiative, called TexPREP, which has received over \$40 million in financial aid and in-kind support from public and private entities; and

**WHEREAS**, in Texas, the program operates in more than 13 cities and 21 college campuses and has served more than 25,000 students, mostly Hispanics; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Berriozábal has received numerous education accolades, including the President's Distinguished Achievement Award for Excellence in University Science at the University of Texas at San Antonio in 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, he was awarded the Yueh-Gin and Dr. Charles Y. Hu Award for Distinguished Service to Mathematics in 2001, the most prestigious award of the Mathematical Association of America, and in 2000 he was inducted into the Texas Science Hall of Fame; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Berriozábal received a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics from Rockhurst College in 1952, a Master of Science in Mathematics from the University of Notre Dame in 1956 and a Ph.D. in Mathematics from the University of California at Los Angeles; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed renaming of Café College to "Dr. Manuel P. Berriozábal cafécollege" was sent forward to the City Clerk and considered by the convened Naming Committee at a Public Hearing on August 1, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the Naming Committee consisted of Diana Sanchez Treviño, a community representative owning a business located within 200 feet of Café College as outlined per City Code, Chapter 6, and as selected by Councilman Bernal since the building resides in City Council District 1 and Gloria Hurtado, the Director of the City's Department of Human Services; and

**WHEREAS**, during the meeting, the Naming Committee approved recommending the "Dr. Manuel P. Berriozábal cafécollege" as the new name for City Council consideration and approval;  
**NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The name, "Dr. Manuel P. Berriozábal cafécollege," is hereby adopted as the new name of Café College, the City's College Access Center as recommended by the convened Naming Committee.

**SECTION 2.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 30th day of August, 2012.







## PURPOSE


- Ordinance authorizing the renaming of Café College to “Dr. Manuel P. Berriozábal cafécollege”

## PUBLIC HEARING

- Per City Code, Chapter 6, a naming committee was convened to gather community input on a proposal to rename Café College to Dr. Manuel P. Berriozábal cafécollege
- Meeting was open to the public and provided time for public comment

## PUBLIC NOTICE

- Committee included owner of business located within 200 feet of Café College and City representative
- Public notice
  - Letters to residents
  - Express News and La Prensa
- DHS received 18 letters in support of the renaming and none in opposition

## PUBLIC HEARING

- Held August 1, 2012
- 17 individuals attended the hearing
- 12 individuals spoke in favor of name change and none in opposition
- 6 individuals submitted comment cards in favor of renaming
- Speakers included former students, colleagues, parents and community members


