THURSDAY, MAY 6TH, A.D.1920, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Ray Lambert, Mayor Pro-tem, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann and Wright. Absent, Mayor Bell.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

AN ORDINANCE *MD-451*

Authorizing purchase of lots 21 and 22, Block 1. Lady of the Lake Addition, for use as a gravel pit, and making appropriation to pay the consideration therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the City of San Antonio purchase from A.G.Startz, for use as a gravel pit, Lots 21 and 22, Block 1, of the Lady of the Lake Townsite Company's re-subdivision of a part of Original City Lot 2, District 5, Range 2, in Bexar County Texas, according to plat on file in the office the County Clerk of Bexar County, Texas, in Book 105. p. 349, which said plat is designated as Lady of the Lake Addition, for the consideration of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00).

SECTION TWO: That the sum of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund, warrant for which shall be drawn payable to the order of said A.G.Startz and paid upon the execution and delivery to the city of San Antonio of a good and sufficient warranty deed conveying the fee simple title to said property to the City of San Antonio, approved as to form by the City Attorney of the City of San Antonio.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$374.12 to pay San Antonio Sewer Pipe Works for one car sewer pipe.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of three hundred, seventy four and 12/100 dollars (\$374.12) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the Sanitary Sewer Fund of 1919 to

pay the San Antonio Sewer Pipe Works for car standard #1 sewer pipe.

Calling for bids for construction of sanitary sewers, Sommerset Road.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City Clerk be and he is hereby directed to advertise for bids for the construction of sanitary sewers on the following streets, to-wit:

Glass, Alvarez and Givens Street, from Halstead to Somersset Road.
Cass, from Mockert Street to Sommersset Road.
Holstead, from Glass to Fivens Street.
Sommerset Road, Glass to Oriental Streets, and from Harriman to Barrett.
Barrett, from Sommersset Road to I & G.N.Ry.
Taft, from Sommersset Road to Garland Street.
Baylor Street from Sommersset to Childress.
according to plans and specifications on file in the City Engineer's office, which will be ready for contractors inspection ob May 17th.

Bids will be received until 4:00 P.M. May 24th, 1920. Bidders chaek required of 10% amount of bid.

RESOLUTION ORDERING STREET IMPROVEMENTS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio:

That a public necessity exists for the improvement of each street and public place in said City named hereunder, and that it is hereby ordered that the same be improved in the manner hereinafter stated, and that special assessments and special taxes be made and levied as provided by law and ordinance on account of the cost of such improvements on each such street and public places, to-wit: (Somersset Road)

The following ordinance was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.



AN ORDINANCE **-454**


