

AN ORDINANCE

2011-11-17-0965

**AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF “LEGEND ROCK” TO
“ROCK POND” BETWEEN “HARDY OAK” AND “PELICAN
CREEK,” LOCATED IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 9, SAN
ANTONIO, TEXAS.**

WHEREAS, in order to eliminate confusion caused by a street with the same name, the renaming of “Legend Rock” to “Rock Pond” is initiated by the Development Services Department with the objective to promote public safety and improve emergency response time to residents within the area; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department staff followed the street renaming process as required by Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted a technical review finding it to conform to City Code requirements for renaming of public streets; and

WHEREAS, this request was forwarded to and reviewed by applicable City of San Antonio Departments and outside agencies and approved; and

WHEREAS, notice of this request to rename said street was properly posted at City Hall, notice was mailed to affected property owners, and notice was disseminated through public service announcements, the notice requirements for renaming streets have been satisfied and further, no written opposition has been received to the name change from property owners; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the Planning Commission was held on September 14, 2011, allowing all interested persons to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission thereafter approved a motion to support the street name change of “Legend Rock” to “Rock Pond”; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The city-owned street known as “Legend Rock” located in City Council District 9 between “Hardy Oak” and “Pelican Creek” is hereby renamed “Rock Pond.” City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$729.52 for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 2312020001 and General Ledger 5301010, as part of the Fiscal Year 2012 Budget.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it becomes effective on the 27th of November, 2011.




