

AN ORDINANCE *01-34*

(FOR PERMISSION TO USE THE CITY SANITARY SEWERS) GRANTING THE PETITION OF
EDWARD W. HEUSINGER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the petition of Edward W. Heusinger, outside the City Limits of the City of San Antonio, for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of S. A. thru means to be made by the Licensee, is granted hereby, subject to the following precedent conditions.

2. That the permit hereby granted is purely pemporary and the City reserves the right to revoke same at any time, with or without notice, for any reason that may in the judgement of the City be sufficient.

3. The connection with the City sewer to be made at the risk of the licensee to Lot 28B, County Block 5644 B.

4. That this permit is intended to cover only the sewerage from the property of the above mentioned petitioner, as same is now situated on said premises at cor. Terrell & New Braunfels Ave., outside of the City limits, and no other person or persons shall be allowed or permitted, by the person to whom this permit is granted, his agents, servants or employees, to use the said City sanitary sewers thru the connection here permitted to be made.

5. That the future purchaser or owner of the above property mentioned in this ordinance, shall compky with all the provisions hereof.

6. That the use to be made of said sewer connection with the City sewerage system shall be subject to the regulation and direction of the City and no use shall be made hereof which might in any way impair the City sewer system or cause same to be obstructed or damaged in any manner whatsoever.

7. That in consideration of the permit hereby granted and the service to be rendered the said licensee hereunder, said grantee agrees to pay the City of San Antonio, as a rental charge, the schedule of fees fixed, and to be fixed, by the ordinances of the City of S. A., said rental commencing on the date of connection made with the City sanitary sewers, but in the event the permit hereby granted is cancelled for any reason, the pro rata amount of said rental shall be returned, less any expense incurred by the City in the premises.

8. That hte inspectors of the City shall have free access to the grantee's premises and all buildings situated thereon during the continuance of this permit and while said premises are connected with said City sanitary sewers, for the purpose of inspecting the condition of the plumbing and the use of said sewers, and that all conditions as herein embodied are being faithfully observed.

9. All expense incident to making this connection with the City sewers shall be borne by the petitioner, and the petitioner shall indemnify, hold and save harm~~pass~~ the City against any loss or damage of any character whatsoever incident to or caused by the use of the facilities here now granted.

10. This ordinance shall become effective upon recording with the County Clerk of Bexar, and the returing of same to the City Clerk for filing as a permanent record, and the filing by the petitioner of a written acceptance of same with the City Clerk.

11. The City of S. A. shall never be liable to the licensee for pecuniary damages for failure to take and treat the sewage of the licensee, said right of action is waived as a part consideration of this permit.

AN ORDINANCE OI-35

(FOR PERMISSION TO USE THE CITY SANITARY SEWERS) GRANTING THE PETITION OF
MRS. W. J. WEHMAN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the petition of Mrs. W. J. Welman outside the City Limits of the City of San Antonio, for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of S. A. thru means to be made by the licensee, is granted hereby, subject to the following precedent conditions.

2. That the permit hereby granted is purely temporary and the City reserves the right to revoke same at any time, with or without notice, for any reason that may in the judgment of the City be sufficient.

3. The connection with the City sewer to be made at the risk of the licensee to Lot 14, County Block 17.

4. That this permit is intended to cover only the sewerage from the property of the above mentioned petitioner, as same is now situated on said premises at East Huff Avenue, outside of the City limits, and no other person or persons shall be allowed or permitted, by the person or persons to whom this permit is granted, his agents, servants or employees, to use the said City sanitary sewers thru the connection here permitted to be made.

AN ORDINANCE *OL-36*

ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE SECURITIES PLEDGED BY THE ALAMO NATIONAL BANK OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, TO SECURE THE CITY FUNDS DEPOSITED AND TO BE DEPOSITED IN SAID BANK BY THE CITY DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1936, AND DIRECTING THE DEPOSITING OF SAID SECURITIES FOR SAFE-KEEPING, AND RELEASING THE SURETIES ON ALL BONDS HERETOFORE GIVEN BY SAID BANK AS CITY DEPOSITORY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the securities pledged with the Governing Body of the City of San Antonio by the Alamo National Bank of San Antonio, Texas as City Depository, to secure the Funds of said City, deposited and to be deposited, in said Bank, during the fiscal year beginning June 1, 1936 and ending May 31, 1937, be and the same are hereby accepted and approved, and that receipt signed by the Mayor, countersigned by the City Auditor, and attested by the City Clerk, be given said Bank for securities pledged by it, which said securities are described as follows:

1.(a) Securities pledged by the Alamo National Bank are described in the attached Exhibit "A", which is made a part of the ordinance by reference as fully as if it were specified herein.

2. The Receipt given to said Bank for the securities pledged by it shall recite, in substance, that the said securities have been duly pledged with the Governing Body of the City of San Antonio, Texas, as a Depository of said City, for the purpose of securing the Funds of said City, deposited and to be deposited, in said Bank during the fiscal year beginning June 1, 1936, upon the terms and conditions prescribed and provided by law.

3. It is directed that said securities be deposited by the Mayor, for safe-keeping, in safe deposit box in the vaults of the Alamo National Bank rented by the City from said Bank.

4. That all sureties on all bonds heretofore given to said City, by said Bank as City Depository, be and are hereby released from further liability as sureties on such bonds.

AN ORDINANCE OI-38

AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON THE STREETS, PLAZAS AND PUBLIC PLACES ON THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES", PASSED AND APPROVED ON THE 8 DAY OF DECEMBER, 1921, AS AMENDED, BY ADDING RULE 65-A.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON THE STREETS, PLAZAS AND PUBLIC PLACES OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES", passed and approved on the 8 day of December 1921, as amended, be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

2. "RULE 65-A. The following streets in the City of San Antonio are hereby designated as the parade route:-

Beginning at Ninth Street and Broadway; down Broadway to Houston Street; west on Houston Street to San Saba Street; south on San Saba Street to Produce Row; east on Produce Row to Santa Rosa Avenue; north on Santa Rosa Avenue to West Commerce Street; east on West Commerce Street to South Alamo Street; north on South Alamo Street to Alamo Plaza; thence on the east side of the Plaza to Avenue "E".

3. "The Police Department of the City of San Antonio is directed to enclose with ropes set in standards the part of the streets to be used by the parade along the route specified herein.

4. "It shall be unlawful and punishable as herein provided for any person to stay within the area enclosed by the ropes after they have been put in place on the parade route.

5. "It shall be unlawful and punishable as provided herein for any person to pass the ropes into the area included between the ropes after the ropes are in place.

6. "It shall be unlawful and punishable as herein provided for any person to cut a rope, break a rope or remove a rope placed along the parade route as specified herein."

7. Whereas, it is necessary for the public safety of the City in the exercise of its police power for the proper regulation of traffic, the control of public streets and the prevention of the blocking and encumbering of the streets in the congested business district, an urgency is created that this ordinance take immediate effect upon its passage; therefore, upon the passage of this ordinance by vote of 4/5 of the Commissioners, it shall be effective, as made and provided by the Charter of the City of San Antonio.

AN ORDINANCE ⁰¹⁻³⁹

2. It is ordered by two-thirds vote of the full board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio that this ordinance shall receive final action without having been read at three several meetings of the Commission.

AN ORDINANCE ⁰⁵⁻⁴⁰

(FOR PERMISSION TO USE THE CITY SANITARY SEWERS)
GRANTING THE PETITION OF: ROBT. C. NEWNAM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the petition of: Robt. C. Newnam outside the city limits of the City of San Antonio, for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of S. A. thru means to be made by the Licensee, is granted hereby, subject to the following precedent conditions.

2. That the permit hereby granted is purely temporary and the City reserves the right to revoke same at any time, with or without notice, for any reason that may in the judgment of the City be sufficient.

3. The connection with the City sewer to be made at the risk of the licensee to connect with lot 2 & pt. 3, County block 10.

4. That this permit is intended to cover only the sewerage from the property of the above mentioned petitioner, as same is now situated on said premises at Thomas Jefferson Drive outside of the City limits, and no other person or persons shall be allowed or permitted, by the person to whom this permit is granted, his agents, servants or employees, to use the said City sanitary sewers thru the connection here permitted to be made.

5. That the future purchaser or owner of the above property mentioned in this ordinance, shall comply with all the provisions hereof.

6. That the use to be made of said sewer connection with the City sewerage system shall be subject to the regulation and direction of the City and no use shall be made hereof which might in any way impair the City sewer system or cause same to be obstructed or damaged in any manner whatsoever.

7. That in consideration of the permit hereby granted and the service to be rendered the said licensee hereunder, said grantee agrees to pay the City of San Antonio, as a rental charge, the schedule of fees fixed, and to be fixed, by the Ordinances of the City of S. A., said rental commencing on the date of connection made with the City sanitary sewers, but in the event the permit hereby granted is cancelled for any reason the pro rata amount of said rental shall be returned less any expense incurred by the City in the premises.

8. That the inspectors of the City shall have free access to the grantee's premises and all buildings situated thereon during the continuance of this permit and while said premises are connected with said City sanitary sewers, for the purpose of inspecting the condition of the plumbing and the use of said sewers, and that all condition as herein embodied are being faithfully observed.

9. All expense incident to making this connection with the City sewers shall be borne by the petitioner, and the petitioner shall indemnify, hold and save harmless the City against any loss or damage of any character whatsoever incident to or caused by the use of the facilities here now granted.

10. This Ordinance shall become effective upon recording with the County Clerk of Bexar, and the returning of same to the City Clerk for filing as a permanent record, and the filing by the petitioner of a written acceptance of same with the City Clerk.

11. The City of S. A. shall never be liable to the licensee for the pecuniary damages for failure to take and treat the sewage, of the licensee, said right of action is waived as a part consideration of this permit.

AN ORDINANCE

MAKING A CONTRACT WITH PAUL WILLIAMS
FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES IN THE
PREPARATION OF THE DELINQUENT TAX RECORD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That this ordinance creates and manifests a contract between the City of San Antonio, a municipality of the State of Texas, termed "city" herein, and Paul Williams, of the City of Austin, County of Travis and State of Texas, termed "contractor" herein, said agreement being made under the power vested by law in the City of San Antonio, in words and figures as follows, to-wit:-

2. That the parties to these presents, each in consideration of the agreement made herein, have mutually agreed and covenanted, and do hereby mutually covenant and agree, the City for itself or its successors, and the Contractor for himself or his successor, as follows, to-wit:

3. The Contractor will prepare and compile a Delinquent Tax Record of the City of San Antonio and a Delinquent Tax Record of the San Antonio Independent School District for the fiscal years 1919 to 1936, both inclusive, showing all unredeemed and uncanceled delinquent taxes for the several years specified remaining charged on the binder records in the office of the Tax Collector of the City of San Antonio for the years shown thereon and on the official tax receipts for the subsequent years, as of 1st of June, 1937; the arrangement and general set-up of the records to be made as required by law; to the satisfaction and approval of the Commissioner of Taxation of the City of San Antonio.

4. The Contractor shall give his personal attention to the execution of this contract and shall employ only competent and skillful persons in the performance thereof.

5. That if at any time the Commissioner of Taxation shall notify the Contractor that any person employed in this work by the Contractor is incompetent, unskillful or disobedient toward any of the officers or employees of the City of San Antonio, which communication shall be considered confidential and privileged, then the Contractor shall discharge forthwith such person and such person shall not be employed again on such work without the written consent of the Commissioner of Taxation.

6. The Contractor shall furnish at the expense of the Contractor all supplies, equipment and personal services necessary to complete the work in a satisfactory condition. The Delinquent Tax Record shall be completed in triplicate, one record to be filed with the Tax Collector of the City of San Antonio, one record to be filed with the City Auditor of the City of San Antonio, and one record with the San Antonio Independent School District.

7. The Delinquent Tax Record shall show each year for which property subject to taxation is reported delinquent or sold to the City for Taxes, the current receipt numbers; the name of the owner at the time of assessment or sale, if known; description of the property contained in the assessment; the assessed value of the property; the amount of all taxes due against the property returned delinquent for each year as shown by the records of the City of San Antonio;

bulk assessment shall be pro-rated according to the value in the original assessment; the land value; the improvement value; the total value; the suit number; the date paid; receipt number and remarks.

8. The record of Delinquent Taxes delivered to the Tax Collector of the City of San Antonio shall be written on thirty-six (36) pound Byron-Weston ledger paper and the other two (2) records shall be on thirty-two (32) pound Byron-Weston ledger paper, and the size of the sheet shall be 17 inches by 22 inches. The records shall be made up in standard 3/4 bindings with hubbed backs, the leaves sewed in sections and sections sewed into a book, with holes punched into the sewing, all secured together with tied buckskin thongs in addition to the sewing.

9. The Contractor will direct the attention of the City Tax Collector to errors in names, descriptions and credits, double assessments and discrepancies coming to the attention of the Contractor during the compilation of the record. The Contractor will employ A. M. Scholz during the period of the compilation of this record for verifying delinquencies, working out double renditions, errors in assessments or credits and determining the true delinquency due the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Independent School District.

10. The work will be started not later than 1 June, 1937, and shall be completed and delivered not later than 1 December, 1937.

11. In consideration of the performance of this contract by the Contractor and the acceptance by the City of San Antonio, the City of San Antonio will pay Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) to the Contractor at the office of the City Treasurer in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas. Partial payments will be made by the City of San Antonio semi-monthly to the Contractor during the progress of the work upon estimates recommended by A. B. Stephens, Chief Deputy Tax Collector, and approved by Frank H. Bushick, Tax Commissioner, not to exceed fifty per cent (50%) of each estimate.

12. The City of San Antonio will give the Contractor full and complete cooperation in all particulars during the progress of the work specified herein, and will give the Contractor such data and information in regard to values of property where proration need to be made between various lots or tracts, and to allow the Contractor working space and light for doing that part of the work required to be done at the City Hall.

13. Exclusive venue in all cases arising under this contract shall be laid in Bexar County, Texas.

14. Should the execution of any work specified by the contract be abandoned by the City of San Antonio the Contractor shall be paid therefor in the proportion that the abandoned work bears to the finished work.

15. Any element that may have been omitted in the description of the work of the Contractor, but which is fairly implied, shall be deemed to be included in this contract, and shall be done by the Contractor as if the same had been specifically stated; without any additional charge to the City.

16. All information collected under the provisions of this agreement shall be the property of the City of San Antonio, and shall not be divulged to any person, and all original data delivered to the City.

17. This ordinance when passed and approved by the governing body of the City of San Antonio and accepted by the Contractor shall constitute the whole contract between the parties thereto.

18. The foregoing instrument in writing constitutes the entire consideration for the execution of this agreement, there being no other written nor any parol agreement with any officer or employee of the City, it being understood that the Charter of the City requires

all contracts of the City to be in writing, and adopted by ordinance.
