

AN ORDINANCE **34413**

CALLING A REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 9TH DAY OF JULY, 1966, ON ORDINANCE NO. 34267 WHICH PROVIDES FOR FLUORIDATION OF THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 34267 passed and approved on April 7, 1966, provided for the fluoridation of the public water supply of the City of San Antonio by the City Water Board; and

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City Clerk on May 16, 1966, requesting that the aforementioned ordinance be repealed or submitted to a vote of the electors and the petition has been determined to be sufficient; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the Council at its regular meeting on June 2, 1966, voted in the negative on the question "Shall the ordinance be repealed" and by resolution declared its intention to call a referendum election at its next regular meeting; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. An election shall be held in the City of San Antonio on the 9th day of July, 1966, at which election a referred ordinance shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the City of San Antonio, said ordinance being substantially as follows:

"ORDINANCE 34267 PASSED AND APPROVED APRIL 7, 1966,  
AUTHORIZING THE FLUORIDATION OF THE CITY PUBLIC WATER  
SUPPLY SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, PROVIDING FOR  
THE REGULATION OF SUCH FLUORIDATION, AND DIRECTING THAT  
SAID FLUORIDATION BE PLACED INTO OPERATION AS SOON AS  
FEASIBLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the Water Works Board of Trustees of the City of San Antonio, Texas is hereby authorized and instructed to proceed with the fluoridation of the public water supply system, after obtaining plans for the necessary equipment, installation, operation and procedures involved in such system by the State Department of Health.

2. That said fluoridation of the public water supply shall be placed into operation as soon as feasible."

SECTION 2. Voting machines shall be employed at said election in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and they shall be used for casting of absentee ballots in the Office of City Clerk.

SECTION 3. Said election shall be held at the polling places in the regularly prescribed voting precincts of the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M., Central Standard Time, such voting and polling places being as follows:

SECTION 4. All qualified electors residing in the City of San Antonio shall be eligible to vote at said election.

SECTION 5. The ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:




SECTION 6. Copies of this ordinance shall serve as proper notice of said election. Copies shall be posted at City Hall and at each of the aforementioned polling places in the City 20 days prior to the date fixed for holding said election. Notice of said election shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to law. The manner of holding said election shall be governed by the laws governing municipal elections.

SECTION 7. Whereas, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, good government and public safety which requires that this ordinance become effective at once; therefore upon the passage of this ordinance by a vote of at least six members of the Council, it shall be effective from and after the date of its passage as provided for by Charter.



The ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:


