

## A RESOLUTION

DECLARING THE CANVASS AND THE RESULT OF A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE 21ST OF JANUARY, 1941, TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS WHO OWN TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID CITY AND WHO HAVE DULY RENDERED THE SAME FOR TAXATION, A CERTAIN PROPOSITION TO BORROW MONEY ON THE CREDIT OF THE CITY AND TO ISSUE BONDS OF THE CITY FOR PERMANENT PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS FOR SAID CITY, FOR A MUNICIPAL AIRPORT, \$550,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. Came on regularly to be canvassed, on this the 22nd day of January, A.D. 1941, the day after the special election to borrow money on the credit of the City of San Antonio and to issue bonds of the City for permanent public improvements for said City, the returns of the special municipal election held on the 21st day of January, A.D. 1941, at which election there was submitted to the qualified voters who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, a certain proposition to borrow money on the credit of the City and to issue bonds of the City for permanent public improvements for said City as fully set out in the Ordinance ordering said election passed and approved on the 19th day of December, A.D. 1940, and as set out in the Proclamation and Notice of Election promulgated by the Mayor on the 19th day of December, A.D. 1940 posted at the several voting places in the 202 precincts in said City and published in the San Antonio Evening News, as required by law, and the Mayor and Commissioners having met to canvass the returns and to declare the result of said election in the manner provided by law, and after considering, determining and canvassing all the matters of fact thereto appertaining; and,

2. WHEREAS, said returns were canvassed by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, and the result of said election declared at their meeting held in the Council Chamber at the City Hall in said City, on the 22nd day of January, A.D. 1941, from which it appears that said proposition to issue \$550,000.00 Municipal Airport Bonds of the City of San Antonio was approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting at said election, the respective votes cast in favor of and against said Proposition to issue bonds of the City of San Antonio, as appears from said returns, and said canvass, being as follows, to-wit:

"FOR"	-- \$550,000.00 Municipal Airport Bonds -----	7,116	votes
"AGAINST"	-- \$550,000.00 Municipal Airport Bonds -----	1,172	votes

3. And it appearing to the Board of Commissioners that said proposition to issue bonds of the City was submitted and that the special election was held and was conducted as required by the Statutes of the State of Texas and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio; and, that at said special election there was cast on such proposition submitting a proposition to borrow money on the credit of the City of San Antonio and to issue bonds for permanent public improvements, the aggregate number of votes marked "FOR" and the aggregate number of votes marked "AGAINST", all as shown by the report and the canvass of said returns by the Board of Commissioners,

and said returns having been found to be correct in all respects, it is declared that the proposition to issue \$550,000.00 Municipal Airport Bonds was adopted by a majority vote of the qualified voters voting at said election.

4. PASSED AND APPROVED AND ADOPTED this the 22nd day of January, A.D. 1941.
