

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO

THURSDAY, AUGUST 17TH, A.D. 1916. 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert, Kearny and Uhr.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

On motion of Commissioner Lambert, duly seconded and carried, a hearing was given to owners of property interested in the improvement of Nolan Street, between subway and Pine Street.

Pursuant to the request of various rifle clubs of the City, for the establishment of a suitable range in the rock quarry section of Brackenridge Park, Commissioners Lambert and Uhr were requested to meet Col. Guessaz, representing the rifle clubs, with a view of agreeing upon a selection of the site requested.

Petition of Deckert and Heilbron to have the curb line defined on Buena Vista Street was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets, Bridges and Public Improvements.

Petition of Dr. G. L. Johnson for correction of assessment, was read and referred to Commissioner Of taxation.

Petition of Ed. Steves and Sons for permit to extend spur track to property south of Idaho Street, was granted on recommendation of Commissioner Kearny.

In the matter of the proposed ordinance granting San Antonio Belt and Terminal Railway Company a franchise to the Eastern city limits, representatives of property owners effected and of the rail road company were present, and entered into lengthy discussions relating to the franchise proposed, when after agreeing to certain changes in the ordinance it was placed upon its first reading, said ordinance being entitled "An Ordinance granting to the San Antonio Belt and Terminal Railway Company the right to construct, maintain and operate a double track, standard guage railroad, including the necessary turn outs, side tracks, switches and telephone and telegraph lines, over and across the San Antonio River, Roosevelt Avenue, Hunstock Avenue, South Presa Street, Plum Street, Hackberry Street, Olive Street, Pine Street, Maryland Avenue, Skinner Avenue, New Braunfels Avenue, Washington Avenue, Gevers Street, Mittman Street, South Walters Street, Adele Street, Westfalls Avenue, Cobception Avenue, K Street, Ogden Avenue, J. Street, I Street, and H Street, all in the City of San Antonio and prescribing the term, consideration and conditions of and for such grant.

On motion duly seconded and carried, the meeting stood adjourned until 4 o'clock P.M. on August 18, 1916.
