

ORDINANCE NO. 48972

ORDINANCE CALLING A BOND ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS :
COUNTY OF BEXAR :
CITY OF SAN ANTONIO :

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and advisable to call the bond election hereinafter ordered.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That an election shall be held on MARCH 4, 1978, in the City of San Antonio, Texas, in the several regular election precincts of said City, and at the several regular polling places, as set forth in "Exhbiit A", which is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes.

2. That at said election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$650,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of the acquisition of property and making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: providing additional City police facilities; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$1,490,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of the acquisition of property and making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: providing additional City fire fighting facilities; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 3

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$69,580,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of the acquisition of property and making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: providing additional storm drainage facilities for said City; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 4

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$15,340,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of the acquisition of property and making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: improving streets and bridges of said City; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 5

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$5,960,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of the acquisition of property and making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: providing additional City public park facilities; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 6

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$2,895,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of the acquisition of property and making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: providing additional City public library facilities; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 7

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$2,500,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of the acquisition of property and making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: aiding in the carrying out of urban renewal projects of said City; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

3. That the official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITIONS, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings, and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITIONS to be expressed substantially as follows:

4. That the Mayor of the City of San Antonio shall appoint the election officers to hold said election, and said election and the absentee voting for said election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code and other applicable law. The City Clerk shall be the clerk for absentee voting for said election, and the office of the City Clerk in the City Hall is hereby designated as the place at which absentee voting shall be conducted for said election, during the regular office hours of said City Clerk. Absentee voting by personal appearance shall commence at the opening of the City Clerk's office on Monday, February 13, 1978, and shall cease at the closing of the City Clerk's office on Tuesday, February 28, 1978. Voting machines shall be used for absentee voting by personal appearance and also for voting at the regular Polling Places at said election; but paper ballots shall be used for absentee voting by mail.

5. That all resident, qualified electors of the City of San Antonio shall be entitled to vote at said election.

6. That notice of said election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Ordinance in each of the Election Precincts of the City of San Antonio and also at the City Hall, not less than 15 days prior to the date set for said election; and a substantial copy of this Ordinance also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio, the date of the first publication to be not less than 14 days prior to the date set for said election.

7. That all bonds voted at said election shall be issued only in accordance with, and subject to all restrictions and requirements of, all applicable law.

8. That this Ordinance is hereby passed as an emergency measure, to be effective immediately upon enactment, such emergency being that the proceeds from the bonds to be voted on as herein provided are required as soon as possible for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, and safety.
