The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: A.Hazlett, for permit to erect gasoline equipment, New Braunfels and Hedges Ave. D.P.Long, for permit to erect electric sign, 327 ST. Mary St.

Petition for the paving of Buckingham Ave. from PresaStreet to Hackberry Street, was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

Bids for constructing Government Hill Sanitary sewers submitted by Hamilton Bros Cons. Co. Elder Bros, F.L.Young and McKenzie Construction Co. were opened and referred to City Engineer for tabulation and report.
