Tuesday, July 10th, A.D. 1917, 4 P.M.

Mayor Bell introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Lambert, Heuermann and Lowther. Absent, Garland. Nays, none.

An ordinance granting to and conferring upon the San Antonio Traction Company and the San Antonio Gas and Electric Company the right to transfer and assign unto the San Antonio Public Service Company, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Texas, all of the rights, privileges and franchises of any and every nature whatsoever now possessed and enjoyed by the said San Antonio Traction Company and San Antonio Gas and Electric Company, subject to all the limitations, duties and obligations imposed upon the said San Antonio Traction Company and San Antonio Gas and Electric Company, and to the requirements and limitations of this ordinance.


