ACCEPTING BID AND AUTHORIZING CONTRACT with Western Paving Company for Street

Improvements on Warwick Boulevard (S. Presa Street to S. Hackberry Street) and appropriating money therefor.

MA-638 AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$567.57 to pay Texas Granitoid Company.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Five Hundred and Sixty Seven and 57/100 (\$567. 57) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Paving Fund to make final payment to Texas Granitoid Company for the paving of Roosevelt Avenue from G. H. & S. A. Ry. tracks to Eads Avenue.

MA-639 AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$84.00 out of the 1915 General Fund to pay the Conness Realty Company for three months rent of two houses used as temporary quarters for City Hospital nurses.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Forty two and no/100 dollars (\$42.00) be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund to pay the Conness Realty Co., Agents, for rent of house 620 North Leona Street, from January 17th, 1916 to April 16th, 1916, being three months in advance at \$14.00 per month;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the sum of Forty two and no/100 Dollars (\$42.00) be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund to pay Conness Realty Company, agents, for rent of house #126 Perez Street from January 22, 1916 to April 22, 1916, being three months in advance at \$14.00 per month.

(Both of these houses are used as temporary quarters for City Hospital Nurses)
