---- MEMORIALS AND PRITITIONS.-----

The following petitions were read and referred to Commssioner of Streets and Public Improvements: Petition of Emmy Dittmar that the name of Dittmar be restored to the street now known as Bismarck street.

Petition of Citizens for the extension of North Comal street to Fredricksburg Road.

The following petitions were read and referred to the Commissioner of Taxation:

Petition of S. C. and E. A. Eldridge for correction of assessment.

Petition of Gulf Coast News and Hotel Co. for correction of assessment.

The following petition was read and referred to the Commissioner of Fire and Police:

Petition of Mildred Baskin for special building permit, and letter from West End Lumber Company giving notice of cancellation of lease of premises occupied by Engine Company No. 15.

No. 291. *MC-698* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$2361.35 for Special Weekly Payrolls.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO: that the sum of \$2361.35 be and is hereby appropriated out of the funds hereinafter named to meet the Special Payrolls for the week ending December 21st, 1918 to-wit:

No. 292. *- 699* AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing Transfer of \$73100.00 into the 1917 General Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that, the following sums be and are hereby appropriated out of the Funds hereinafter named for transfer into the 1917 General Fund to-wit:

No. 293. **MC-700** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$5050.06 to pay interest and exchange on Bonds.

No. 294. **-701** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$113,025.00 to pay notes Nos. 3 and 4 for \$55,000.00 with interest thereon.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that the sum of \$113,025.00 be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund to pay principal and interest on notes Nos. 3 and 4 in the sum of \$55,000.00 each, dated July 1st, 1918 and due and payable January 1, 1919, Note No. 3 being payable to the order of the Alamo National Bank, and note No. 4 being payable to the State National Bank.
