

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN  
THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL  
ON THURSDAY, JUNE 30TH, 1960, AT 8:30A.M.

The meeting was called to order by the presiding officer Mayor J. Edwin Kuykendall with the following members present: KUYKENDALL, McMAHON, JOHNSON, SIMPSON, OLIVARES, PINSON AND DE LA GARZA; ABSENT: DIETERT AND PASSUR.

The invocation was by the Rev. C. Reginald Hardy, Pastor of the Los Angeles Heights Methodist Church.

On motion of Dr. McMahon the Council dispensed with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting.

Mr. Al Tripp, Purchasing Agent, stated that annual contracts for supplies would be considered and that a certain number of tie bids have been submitted and in accordance with the State Law it would be necessary to draw lots in order to determine the low bidder.

The Mayor announced that in the drawings, the bidder drawing the low number would be award the contract on the tie bids.

The first drawing was to determine the low bidder on Items 2, 3 and 5, to furnish manhole rings and covers. Alamo Iron Works drew the low number on Items 2 and 3, and San Antonio Machine and Supply Company the low number for Item 5. Next heard was the postponed hearing on zoning case 1177 to rezone Lot 32, NCB 8695 to "F" Local Retail District. The Planning Director stated the Planning Commission had twice heard the case and on both occasions recommended the change. Mr. Walter Gray, attorney for the petitioner Mr. Cooper, asked for approval of the change for an expansion of the Aloha Motel. Mr. Cooper stated all the adjacent property owners were in favor except 2 persons. Mrs. George Andrews of 122 Deerwood objected to the change and accused Mr. Cooper of violating the zoning ordinance by renting duplexes on Deerwood to transients. Mrs. Lucille Athens also complained of the present zoning violation. After discussion and consideration of the matter Dr. McMahon moved that the Council delay action for one week to determine how original zoning occurred in that area and a report on violations in the case of the duplexes. The motion carried by the following vote: AYES: Kuykendall, McMahon, Simpson, Olivares and de la Garza; NAYS: Johnson and Pinson; ABSENT: Dietert and Passur.

Mr. William E. Jauer of 303 Teakwood praised the Council for improvements made in the City and asked it to resubmit the Expressway Bond issue to the people, together with a program of education on the issue and the sewer charge as both are needed.

Mrs. Mattie Lou Williams stated she was against bond issues. Mr. Larry Moon endorsed another bond issue, as did Mr. Antonio Trevino and Mr. Max Penner.

Mr. Henry Hart stated if the bond issue is resubmitted the Council should consider separate propositions and change the route of the North Expressway to the West. Mr. H. Quintanilla also endorsed another bond issue. Mr. Kristgen Bredvad stated the people in his area was against the bond issue. The Mayor told all interested parties that they have the matter under consideration and would probably render a decision next week.

Mr. R. B. Westbrook, stated the people in the San Fernando Water Co. District were not against progress. He said the Highway 90 West route would take their homes and part of the San Fernando Water Plant which would deprive them of their water supply and therefore were against the last issue. He asked the Council consider re-routing Highway 90 West.

AFTER RECESS OF FIVE MINUTES

A hearing set for this time Amending the City Code Section 42 to permit use of temporary sales offices in new subdivisions where homes are being disposed of was called up. The Planning Director briefed the Council on the matter and recommended adoption of Amendments.

Mr. E. S. Johnson, President of San Antonio Home Builders commented on the provisions and Mr. Barney Cox was also heard. The Council then approved the recommendation for a change by adopting the following ordinance. AYES: Kuykendall, McMahon, Johnson, Simpson, Olivares, Pinson and de la Garza; NAYS: None.
