

A RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO ADVERTISE  
FOR BIDS FOR MOVING, PLACING AND CONN-  
ECTING VOTING MACHINES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that,

1. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to advertise for sealed bids, addressed to the City Clerk, City Hall, San Antonio 5, Texas, for moving, placing, connecting and returning approximately 220 voting machines to and from the Bexar County Court House to the polling places located in the various election precincts listed in the Proclamation and Notice of Election on file in the office of the City Clerk, for use in the Charter Amendment Election to be held May 9, 1950.

2. The bid shall be in duplicate, and the envelope containing the bid shall be endorsed "Bid for Moving Voting Machines".

3. Bids will be received at the office of the City Clerk until 10:00 o'clock A.M., Thursday the 6th day of April 1950 and then publicly opened and read aloud in the City Council Chamber. Any bids received after the closing time will be returned unopened.

4. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive formality.

5. Advertisement shall be made by the publication of this Resolution for five (5) days in the "COMMERCIAL RECORDER".
