## AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing acceptance of certain deeds of conveyance, and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

that, the City of San Antonio does hereby accept deeds of conveyance for land needed for widening of Bowie Street, between Blum Street and Commerce Street, and for the widening of Water Street, from the following parties, to-wit:

1st. From Mary Weyel part of lot 82, C.B.153, the consideration being the construction of a sidewalk and curb in front of the remaining part of said lot.

2nd. From Mary Weyel and Albert Weyel part of lot 81, C.B.153, the consideration being construction of sidewalk and curb in front of the remaining part of said lot, and the payment of \$100.00 in cash.

3rd. From Oswald Hermann part of lot 16, C.B.696, on the south east side of Water Street, the consideration being the payment of \$70.00 in cash.

All of said parcels of land herein referred to being fully described in the deeds hereby authorized to be accepted.

4th, That the sum of \$170.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund to pay the cash consideration herein stipulated.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$409.08 out of the 1917 General Fund to pay the Galveston, Harrisburg and San Antonio Ry. Co. for freight charges on one car Tarvia A used for street work.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the sum of Four hundred Nine and 8/100 Dollars (\$409.08) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund to pay the G.H. & S.A. Ry. co, for freight charges on 10,047 gallons Tarvia (one car) shipped from Barret Mfg Co., Ensley, Ala, 8/9/17 for use of street maintenance department. AN ORDINANCE

Accepting proposal of H.D.Moutandan for paving an alley and uthorizing contract and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. (Acceptance) That the City does hereby accept the attached written proposal of said party named in the caption hereof, dated Dec. 1. 1917 and offering to pave an alley running from Avenue D to Avenue E on the north side of the Elks Building in and for said City in accordance with the written specifications and description and drawings prepared and submitted by the City Engineer

Section 2. (Appropriation) That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises, the sum of Seven Hundred and Fifty \$750.00 Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund and said funds so appropriated shall be kept in a seperate account to be designated as special fund for paving alley between Avenue D and Avenue E.

Commissioner Lowther recommended that petitions of Princess Theatre for permit to erect two electric signs; also petition of F.Pena for change in Jitney route, be granted. Adopted.

Commissioner Lowther submitted a communication from the City Purchasing Agent recommending that a Police Patrol motor be purchased from Suchy-Wheeler Co. (White) for \$2500.00. Adopted.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$250.00 out of the 1917 General Fund to pay Frank Zizik for injuries received in a collision with Officer East, at the corner of Water and E.Commerce Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, there be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars, warrant to be made payable to Frank Zizik in full settlement for personal injuries received in a collision with officer East on June 15, 1917, at the intersection of Commerce and Water Streets in San Antonio, Texas.
