

## MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, JUNE 18TH, A.D. 1917, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Heuermann and Lowther. Absent, Lambert.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

## ----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition of Shortwell and Price for permit to conduct shooting gallery was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Petition for opening of Gaines Street, from Zarzamoras Street to San Antonio Street, was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

Petition for water mains in Muncey Street was read and referred to Commissioner of Sanitation Parks and Public Property.

Petition of C.S. Warnock, for building permit, was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Commissioner Heuermann recommended that petitions of John Rodriguez for permit to charge for sewer connections on Jonas Street and W. Cypress Street, were granted.

Commissioner Garland introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Garland, Heuermann and Lowther.

*MB-665* AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City Auditor be and he is hereby ordered to transfer balances as shown on his books on May 31, 1917; that is in 1911, 1912, 1913 and 1914 general funds into the back tax General Fund; and that the City Treasurer be ordered to transfer all balances and covered by City Collectors report of May 31, 1917, Deposit warrant No. 78, in 1903, 1904, 1905, 1906, 1907, 1908, 1909, 1910, 1911, 1912, 1913 and 1914, into the Back Tax Fund.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

Commissioner Garland introduced the following ordinance which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Brown, Garland, Heuermann and Lowther.  
No. 23. *-666* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$53.00 out of judgement fund to pay costs in condemnation proceedings.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Fifty Three (\$53.00) Dollars be appropriated out of the judgement fund, to Frank R. Newton, County Clerk of Bexar County, to pay the costs in cause No. 49, City of San Antonio vs A.G. Witte et al. condemnation proceedings in County Court.

No. 24. *-667* AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the 1916 General Fund, the following sums of moneys for the hereinafter designated purposes;

Seventy Two Dollars and Thirty Seven cents (\$72.37) (the school portion being \$17.44) warrant for which is to be made payable to T.W. Campbell, on account of erroneous assessment and collection of taxes for the fiscal year 1916, on one lot in New City Block Number 913, on valuation of \$4,360.00.

No. 25. *MB-668* AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the payment of wages to City Laborers for week ending June 16, 1917 and making an appropriation therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to issue warrants for the payment of wages to City Day Laborers for the week ending June 16, 1917 and that the following sums be and are hereby appropriated out of the several special funds for that purpose, to-wit:

Petition of E.J.McNerney, for permit to build a dancing pavillion was granted on recommendation of Building Inspector.
