

AN ORDINANCE **101400**

ESTABLISHING A NEW FEE ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROVISION OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES, RESULTING IN ADDITIONAL REVENUE TO THE GENERAL FUND; AND AMENDING THE CORRESPONDING SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

WHEREAS, it is advisable to create a new fee for recovery of costs associated with commercial trench/confined space rescue incidents; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the City Code of San Antonio, Texas to reflect this new fee; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. Section 11-16 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended by adding subsection (w) as follows:

(w) A fee of four hundred forty dollars (\$440.00) per hour is hereby established for recovery of costs associated with commercial trench/confined space rescue incidents.

SECTION 2. All other Subsections of Sections 11-16 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas not specifically amended herein shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 2005.

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the creation of a new fee for recovery of costs associated with commercial Trench/Confined Space Rescue incidents, resulting in \$3,428 in additional revenue to the General Fund.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The San Antonio Fire Department is proposing the creation of a Trench/Confined Space Rescue Fee for commercial incidents. The fee of \$440 per hour per apparatus (plus any personnel overtime and consumables) would allow the department to recoup its personnel and material costs associated with these rescues.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The ordinance continues existing City policy of requiring users of City services to offset some of the costs associated with operating and maintaining those services.

FISCAL IMPACT


The proposed fee would provide an additional \$3,428 in revenue to the General Fund in FY 2005-2006.

COORDINATION


This ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget and City Attorney's Office.
