AN ORDINANCE **34587**

CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULT OF A REFERENDUM ELECTION HELD JULY 9, 1966, ON AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR FLUORIDATION OF THE CITY'S WATER SUPPLY.

* * * *

WHEREAS, Ordinance 34267 passed and approved on April 7, 1966, provided for fluoridation of the public water supply of the City; and

WHEREAS, prior to the expiration of the period prescribed by Charter, a petition bearing the valid signature of the required number of qualified voters of the City of San Antonio was duly filed requesting that said ordinance be repealed or a referendum election be held on said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, in response to said petition, by Ordinance 34413 of June 9, 1966, ordered that a referendum election on said ordinance be held on Saturday, July 9, 1966, on said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and legally held on the 9th day of July, 1966, in conformity with the Charter and the election ordinance heretofore passed by the City Council, and the result of said election has been certified and returned to this Council by the proper officials; and

WHEREAS, this Council has this day considered the returns of said election on the proposition hereinabove stated; and

WHEREAS, said election was in all respects lawfully held and said returns duly and legally made and there were cast at said election the following votes:

"Ordinance No. 34267 passed and approved the 7th day of April, 1966, providing for the fluoridation of the public water supply of the City of San Antonio. FOR THE ORDINANCE."


NOW, THEREFORE:






VOTING MACHINES.
ORDER APPROVING THE RENTAL OF 162 SHOUP VOTING
MACHINES TO THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO BE USED TO
HOLD A SPECIAL REFERENDUM ELECTION ON SATURDAY,
JULY 9, 1966.

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Ollie Wurzbach, duly seconded by County Commissioner Albert A. Pena, Jr., which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Pena, Wurzbach and Judge Grace voting "Aye:" It is ordered by the Court that the rental of 162 Shoup voting machines to the City of San Antonio, to be used to hold a Special Referendum Election on Saturday, July 9, 1966, be and hereby is approved. Said rental shall be at the rate of \$25.00 per machine, which fee is to include the cost of preparing and servicing said machines. The City of San Antonio is to pay the drayage of said machines from the Bexar County Election Center and the return of said machines to the Bexar County Election Center. The City of San Antonio shall assume all liability for damages to or destruction of said machines directly caused by the negligence of the City of San Antonio, its officers, agents, servants, and/or employees while said machines are in the actual custody of the City of San Antonio.
