
Bid of Lassner Feed Stores for furnishing feed for the Fire Department was opened and referred to the City Purchasing Agent for tabulation and recommendation.

Bids for furnishing cement to the Street Department of the city were on motion of Commissioner Rieden held over until next meeting of the council.



AN ORDINANCE

Ordering condemnation of a strip of land for extension of Lakeview Ave.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section One: That the opening of Lake View Avenue from Soledad Street to the River to connect with Martin Street is hereby declared to be of public necessity, and said property is hereby declared to be necessary in order to complete the said extension, and it is also necessary for the City of San Antonio to appropriate by condemnation proceedings, the following described property, to-wit:Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot No. A-4 in City Block No. 139 at the corner of an alley on the east line of Soledad Street, as shown on accompanying plat which is made a part of these field notes,Thence in an easterly direction with the north line of lot No. A-4, a distance of 204 feet to the San Antonio River, Thence down the San Antonio river with its meanderings to a point on the new established south line of Lakeview Avenue extension, Thence in a westerly direction with the new established south line of Lakeview Avenue extension, a distance of 226 feet to a point on the east line of Soledad Street, Thence in a northerly direction with the east line of Soledad Street a distance of 4.32 feet to the place of beginning.Section Two: Whereas, the City of San Antonio has been unable to agree upon the price of said property with Mrs. Margaret Favill and all other owners of said property, upon the price thereof.

WHEREFORE, it is now further ordained that the City of San Antonio proceed without delay to condemn said property in the manner provided by law, and that the City Attorney be and he is now hereby directed to institute the necessary proceedings and represent the City of San Antonio in the condemnation proceedings now here provided for, and that a plat of the property proposed to be condemned be filed with the City Clerk.

Section Three: That the City Attorney is instructed to make any and all necessary parties defendant in the condemnation proceedings, including any mortgagors, lien holders or lessees, or any parties owning or claiming any interest of whatever character in the property.

Section One: That the sum of \$110.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund and charged to the Department of Fire and Police, to pay the salary of Dave Coy as Captain of Police of the City of San Antonio for the first twenty-two days in June, 1919.Section Two: The Auditor of the City of San Antonio is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrant in said sum of \$110.00, payable to said Dave Coy, in payment of said salary.
