UNTIL 11:00 A.M. WITH AN ALTERNATE RAIN DATE OF SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 1995, AS REQUESTED BY ROGER FLORES, II AND LYNDA BILLA BURKE.**

**WHEREAS**, in order to minimize noise, the bikes will be pushed into place for the photograph; **NOW THEREFORE;**


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**


