AN ORDINANCE *- 1111*

Appropriating \$50,000.00 to pay January merchants bills.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Thirty Thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1920 General Fund to pay duly approved merchants bills for month of January 1921, per itemized invoices on file in office of the City Auditor

Commissioner Coy made the following recommendations, which were read and adopted: F.A.Haecker, for cancellation of taxes, granted. Mary B. Gaenslen, for correction of assessment, refused.

Pierce Oil Corporation for permit to erect electric sign on Bowens Island was granted on recommendation of City Electrician.

Commissioner Wright submitted the name of Mrs Hugh B. Rice for appointment to the position of Chairman of the Board of Censors for public vaudeville and moving pictures shows; which appointment was confirmed by confirmative vote of all of the members of the Board.

He also recommended that Mrs Lillian Rogers, Mrs S.C.Kile, Mrs J.K.Beretta, and Miss Hannah Hirschberg be permitted to serve as assistants to Mrs Rice, without pay from City of San Antonio, which recommendation was adopted by unanimpus vote.
