

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, JULY 2ND, A.D.1917. 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert, Heuermann and Lowther.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition requesting the change in name of Colquitt Avenue to Waco Avenue, was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

Petition for water mains on Sandoval Street was read and referred to Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public property.

Commissioner Garland introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Garland, Lambert, Heuermann and Lowther:

No. 40 *MB-693* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$10,697.72 to pay judgement to San Antonio Loan and Trust Company.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Ten Thousand Six Hundred and Ninety seven Dollars and Seventy -Two cents (\$10,697.72) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund for the purpose of paying the San Antonio Loan and Trust Company an old judgement taken over by them from the San Antonio School Board.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

Commissioner Garland introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Garland, Lambert, Heuermann and Lowther.

No. 41. *694* AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the 1916 General Fund, the following sums of moneys for the hereinafter designated purposes:
Six Dollars and Eighty Five cents (\$6.85) (the school portion being \$1.68), warrant for which is to be made payable to Aug. Mugge on account of erroneous assessment and collection of taxes for the fiscal year 1916 on lot Number Twelve (12) in N.C.B. 3083 on valuation of \$420.00

Mr. Franz Groos appeared before the Commissioners requesting an appropriation of \$250.00 for the entertainment of the military stationed here which was refused.

The consideration of bids for space in City Market House was postponed until July 16, 1917.

Bids for sidewalk construction on E. Crockett Street were opened and referred to City Engineer.

Bids for printing public notices were read and referred to City Purchasing Agent.

Commissioner Lambert introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Garland, Lambert, Heuermann and Lowther.

No. 42 *MB-675* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars to pay E.Haenig.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars be and is hereby appropriated to pay Mr. E.Haenig for extra plumbing inspection work on account of Assistant plumbing inspector doing pipe work and repairs in public park.

Commissioner Lambert recommended that petition of colored citizens for use of San Pedro Park on Fourth of July be granted. Adopted.

The report of the Health Department on inspection of milk and food stuff for the month of June was received and ordered filed.

Petition of Sun Set System for permit to erect two sign boards on Lot A, C.B.993 was granted on recommendation of City Building Inspector.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
