AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 32292 APPROVING THE UNDERTAKING OF SURVEYS AND PLANS FOR URBAN RENEWAL PROJECT NO. 5 (CIVIC CENTER PROJECT) AND APPROVING THE SUBMISSION BY THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO OF A REVISED APPLICATION FOR AN ADVANCE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR SAID PURPOSE, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 32292 approving the undertaking of surveys and plans for Urban Renewal Project No. 5 (Civic Center Project), Tex. R-83, and approving the submission by the Urban Renewal Agency of the City of San Antonio of a revised application for an advance of federal funds for said purpose, and repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith, was passed and approved by the City Council of the City of San Antonio on the 7th day of May, 1964; and

WHEREAS, certain statements and affirmations required by Federal law and regulation for qualification of said surveys and plans were inadvertently omitted from said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the public interest that Section 3 of said ordinance be amended to include the omitted statements and affirmations required by Federal law and Federal administrative regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 32292 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. That it is cognizant of the conditions that are imposed in the undertaking and carrying out of urban renewal projects with Federal financial assistance under Title I, including those relating

to (a) the relocation of site occupants; (b) the provision of local grants-in-aid; (c) the prohibition of discrimination because of race, color, creed, or national origin with respect to housing, facilities related to residential use, and all public facilities within a project area; public facilities proposed as noncash local grants-in-aid; and employment; and (d) the requirement that the locality present to the Housing and Home Finance Administrator, as a prerequisite to approval of the application described below, a workable program for community improvements, as set forth in Section 101(c) of Title I, for utilizing appropriate public and private resources to eliminate and prevent the development or spread of slums and urban blight."

Section 2. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
