Appropriating \$1832.25 for pay rolls for the week ending March 16, 1918. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to issue warrants for the payment of wages to City Day Laborers for the week ending March 16, 1918, and that the following sums be and are hereby appropriated out of the several General and Special funds for that purpose, towit:

1917 General Fund.....\$1832.25.

The petition of Geo, M, Padgitt for permit to install a gasoline pump and tank on North Laredo Street not less than 30 feet from the intersection of Houston Street, was granted.

On motion duly seconded and carried the Mayor was authorized to appoint as many Special Policeman as might be required to enforce the Laws.
