## AN ORDINANCE

ME-1392  
Appropriating the sum of TWO HUNDREDED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000.00) out of the interest of 1922 General Fund, payable to City National Bank of San Antonio, Texas to retire Five Notes Nos. 32 to 36 inc. of a series of notes Nos. 1 to 46 inc, in the principal sum of \$50,000.00 each, payable to City National Bank. Also appropriating \$4,500.00 out of 1922 General Fund, Contingencies Dept. to pay intrest on said 5 notes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the sum of \$250,000.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of 1922 General Fund, payable to City National Bank of San Antonio, Texas, to retire Five Notes Nos. 32 to 36 inclusive, of a series of Notes Nos. 1 to 46 inc., in the principal sum of \$50,000.00 each, payable to City National Bank, dated Jan. 15th, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum, maturing on or before June 1st, 1923. said notes having been issued in prsuance of an ordinance passed by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio on the 15th, day of Jan. 1923, which ordinance is reported in Vol. E Page 336 et Seq. of the Minutes of the Commissioners, on file in the City Clerks Office.

SECTION TWO: That the sum of \$4,500.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same is hereby appropriated out of 1922 General Fund (Contingencies Dept.) payable to said City National Bank, to pay interest on said 5 notes Nos. 32 to 36 inc. said interest being at the rate of 5% per annum from Feb. 15th 1923 to date of retirement.

SECTION THREE: The City is hereby authorized and directed to prepare proper warrants in said amounts and to deliver same to said City National Bank upon date of payment of said amounts.

Providing for the Transfer of Certain Funds.
