

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

FRIDAY, DECEMBER 19th, 1924, at 10:00 A. M.

PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Steffler and Wright. Absent Lamert.

Commissioner Bushick, introduced the following ordinances which were read and adopted by the following vote on roll call to-wit; Ayes, Tobin, Bushick, Steffler, Wright.

MF-1118 AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing settlement with C. Villemain of claims against him for the Widening and Straightening of West Commerce Street, from Main Plaza to the City Market.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the proportion of C. Villemain to pay to the City the sum of \$1,020.00. in full settlement of all claims due under and by virtue of an ordinance passed and approved on November 20, 1916, levying special assessment on account of the widening and straightening of West Commerce Street from Main Plaza to the City Market, and assessed against that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, fronting on West Commerce Street, at the corner of South Santa Rosa Avenue, between said Santa Rosa Avenue and Laredo Street, known as Lot No. 1, City Block No. 138, said lot having a frontage on the South side of said West Commerce Street of 49.3 feet, said assessment being also a personal liability against the said C. Villemain, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the same having now been paid, the Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver proper and sufficient release therefor; and the said C. Villemain having on Dec. 9th, 1916, filed suit in the 45th Dist. Court of Bexar County, Texas, being No. B-14404, he, the said C. Villemain now agrees and binds himself to dismiss said cause, and to pay all costs of said suit.

No. 263 *MF-1119* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating money out of 1922 General Fund to pay sundry bills incurred during 1922 and prior.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Eleven Hundred and seventy-five Dollars (\$1175.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund (Various Depts) to pay Merchants bills as per invoices, and claims, on file in the Office of the City Auditor.

Commissioner Steffler, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes; Tobin, Bushick, Steffler, Wright.

No. 264 *MF-1120* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating the sum of \$7500.00 for Park Purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars, be and is hereby appropriated out of the Park Improvement Fund of 1924; and the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars out of the 1924 General (Contingent) Fund, for the purpose of acquiring a park site at Woodlawn Lake.

Commissioner Wright, introduced the following resolution, which was read and adopted.

MF-1121 RESOLUTION

Authorizing the purchase of one Heatrola for use in Fire Dept. Station.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the Purchasing Agent be and he is hereby directed to purchase 1 #4 Estate Heatrola from Praeger Hardware Co. for the sum of \$140.00 to be used in Fire Dept. Station No. 6.

Commissioner Steffler, introduced the following ordinance which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Tobin, Bushick, Steffler, Wright.

MF-1122 AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Mayor to sell and convey to W. M. Graham and E. J. Collins, the tract of land at the Northeast intersection of Yturri Street and Market Street, New City Block 109.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That John W. Tobin, Mayor, is hereby authorized to grant, sell and convey, by deed, for and in consideration of the sum \$13,500.00 cash, and the assumption by the City of the widening Benefit Assessment against the property, that certain tract of land at the northeast corner of Market and Yturri Streets, in New City Block 109, having a frontage of 73.24 feet on Market Street and 41.1 feet on Yturri Street, being the remainder of the property purchased from H. O. Lassner for the widening of Market Street not necessary for that purpose. All taxes for the current fiscal year are to be prorated as of the date of the deed.

Commissioner Bushick, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit, Ayes; Tobin, Bushick, Steffler, Wright.

MF-1123 AN ORDINANCE

Repealing an ordinance authorizing purchase of certain lots from Mark F. Postlewaite and wife.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, certain ordinance authorizing the City to purchase from Mark F. Postlewaite and wife Maude Postlewaite Lots Nos. 8 - 9 - 10 - 11 in N. C. B. 268, passed and approved by the Commissioners on December 1, 1924, be and is hereby repealed and declared of no effect, and that the appropriation therein made and numbered to the City Auditor as 238, is hereby cancelled.
