AN ORDINANCE 53344

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 53288 CALLING THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 4, 1981, IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MEMBERS TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND ON A PROPOSED BOND ISSUE FOR RESTORING MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM, SO AS TO CORRECT THE AMOUNT OF BONDS AUTHORIZED TO BE ISSUED.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Antonio adopted Ordinance No. 53288 on January 22, 1981, calling the regular municipal election and a bond election to be held on April 4, 1981, in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, for the purpose of electing the members to the City Council of the City of San Antonio and on a proposed bond issue for restoring Municipal Auditorium; and,

WHEREAS, at said election all resident, qualified electors of the City of San Antonio shall be entitled to vote "For" or "Against" authorizing the issuance of \$9,100,000 of Municipal Auditorium restoration bonds by the City Council of the City of San Antonio; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 53288 be and the same is hereby amended by deleting "\$9,412,000" and inserting "\$9,100,000" so that said section shall hereafter be and read as follows:

SECTION 2. That at said election the following PROPOSITION shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$9,100,000 with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: restoring the Municipal Auditorium; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy, and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

SECTION 2. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 53288 be and the same is hereby amended by deleting "\$9,412,000" and inserting "\$9,100,000" so that said section shall hereafter be and read as follows:

SECTION 3. The official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings, and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITION to be expressed substantially as follows:

SUBJECT: An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 53288 calling the Regular Municipal Election and Bond Election on April 4, 1981 Date January 29, 1981

SUMMARY

This ordinance would amend Ordinance No. 53288 adopted by the City Council on January 22, 1981, calling the regular municipal election and a bond election on April 4, 1981. This amendment involves correcting an error in the amount of bonds authorized to be issued for the restoration of Municipal Auditorium should the bond proposition be approved by the voters of San Antonio.


BACKGROUND

The City Council adopted Ordinance No. 53288 calling the regular municipal election and a bond election to be held on April 4, 1981, for the purpose of electing the members to the City Council of the City of San Antonio and on a proposed bond issue for restoring Municipal Auditorium. Due to a clerical error the ordinance approved January 22, 1981 authorized the City Council to issue up to \$9,412,000 of Municipal Auditorium restoration bonds upon approval of the bond proposition by the voters of San Antonio.

The proposed ordinance corrects this error by amending Ordinance No. 53288 to allow for the issuance of \$9,100,000 in restoration bonds upon passage by the voters on April 4, 1981.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that this ordinance be approved.
