the previous Ordinance (No. 89159) as listed on Attachment I; **NOW THEREFORE:**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

hereof.



FINANCIAL IMPACT


This expenditure has been budgeted in the Elections budget.

COORDINATION


This ordinance was coordinated with the Bexar County Elections Office and the North Side Independent School District.
