Issue Proposed for Consideration

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest available meeting of the Governance Committee:

I respectfully ask for your concurrence in requesting the Department of Planning and Neighborhood Services to take the necessary steps to bring forward to City Council an amendment to the Major Thoroughfare Plan for Gold Canyon Road from Redriver to Bulverde Road.

Brief Background

Gold Canyon Road is currently planned as a corridor that would go through a residence prior to it intersecting Bulverde Rd and then through an active quarry. The current Major Thouroughfare Plan for Gold Canyon Road would negatively affect the area neighborhood association and the Yates Property and Trust.

The proposed amendment would alter the layout of the road and create a path north and east to Bulverde Road. The proposed realignment of Gold Canyon would intersect Bulverde Road across from Canyon Parkway. A secondary arterial would intersect with Roseheart. Splitting the traffic will provide an easier, less impactful traffic flow to the surrounding area (see map attached). This design has received the support of the neighborhood associations in the area, the District 10 Alliance and the Yates Property and Yates Trust, whose property this road would go through in the future.
