

AN ORDINANCE 88-81

PRESCRIBING LIMITS WITHIN WHICH IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO DRIVE LOOSE STOCK THROUGH ANY OF THE STREETS, ALLEYS OR PLAZAS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, PRESCRIBING THE PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1: That it shall be unlawful for any person to drive loose stock through any of the streets, alleys or plazas of the City of San Antonio, within the following limits, to-wit: Commencing on Broadway at the city limits; thence southwest in a direct line to the intersection of Donaldson Avenue and Fredericksburg Road; thence west on Donaldson Avenue to Clark Avenue; thence south on Clark Avenue to the intersection of West Woodlawn and Bancroft Street; thence on Bancroft Street to Goodrich Avenue; thence south on Goodrich Avenue to Culebra Avenue; thence west on Culebra Avenue to 19th Street; thence south on 19th Street to Guadalupe Street; thence east on Guadalupe Street to Hamilton Avenue; thence south on Hamilton Avenue to Saltillo Street; thence east on Saltillo Street to South San Marcos Street; thence south on South San Marcos Street to Powell Street; thence southeast on Powell Street to Somerset Road; thence southwest on Somerset Road to Edwards Street; thence south on Edwards Street to Bigfoot Street; thence east on Bigfoot Street to South Flores Street; thence north on South Flores Street to West Mitchell Street; thence east on West Mitchell Street to Concepcion Road; thence south on Concepcion Road to Hansford Street; thence east on Hansford Street to South Presa Street; thence north on South Presa Street to Rockwood Court; thence east on Rockwood Court to South Hackberry Street; thence north on South Hackberry Street to Steves Avenue; thence east on Steves Avenue to South Walters Street; thence north on South Walters Street to North Walters Street; thence north on North Walters Street to G. H. & S. A. tracks; thence north on Moore Street from the G. H. & S. A. tracks to the Seguin Road; thence east on the Seguin Road to the City Limits; thence north along the City Limits to the northern boundary of the City of San Antonio; thence west along the City Limits to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2: Every person whomsoever who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, or who shall fail or refuse to observe and comply with said provisions, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) nor more than TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00), and, in default of payment of said fine, shall be committed to the city prison.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: For reason of public safety and welfare apparent herefrom, this ordinance is declared to be of urgent importance and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

 AN ORDINANCE *89-82*

Declaring the necessity for the widening and straightening of So. Flores Street between
 Doloresa St. and Nueva Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That a public necessity exists for the improvement of So. Flores St, in the City of
 San Antonio, Texas, by widening and straightening the same, between its intersection with
 the south line of Doloresa Street, and its intersection with the north line of Nueva Street,
 so that said So. Flores Street shall hereafter have a average width of eight ^{two} feet between
 property lines from Doloresa St, to Nueva St, and that special assessments and taxes shall
 be made and levied, as provided by law and ordinance, on account of the cost of such improve-
 ments.

11. The improvement shall in general consist of the widening and straightening of said
 street between the points aforementioned by setting back the street and sidewalk lines,
 removing such improvements as may be necessary, and acquiring such property as may be required,
 and the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare plans, profiles, plats and specifications
 covering the proposed improvement and to report same to the Commissioners, forthwith, to-
 gether with a statement of the estimated cost of such improvement, the name of the property
 owners abutting thereon, the description of said property, and the amount, if any, to be
 assessed against such owners and said property, as their or its proportion of the cost of
 making such improvement.

111. That the cost of said improvements shall be discharged as follows:

(a) An amount not exceeding three-fourths of the whole cost thereof shall be paid by the
 owners of property abutting thereon and assessed against them and their property, as provided
 for in the Improvement Ordinance, provided that no such assessment shall be made against
 any owner of property in excess of benefits thereto in enhanced value thereof by reason of
 the making of said improvements, nor until after the legal notice and hearing of such
 property owners.

(b) The remainder of the cost of said improvements to be paid by the City of San Antonio.
